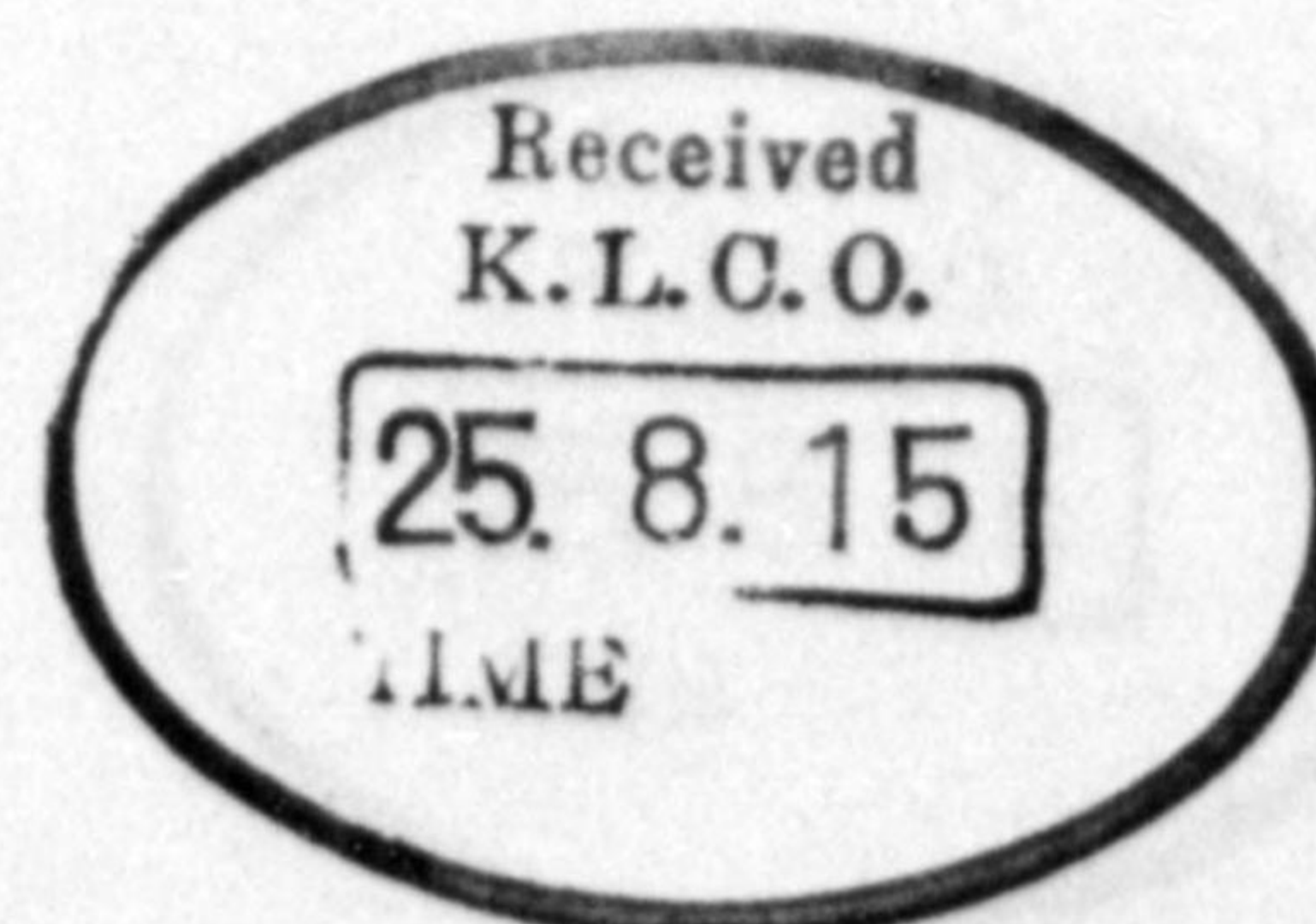

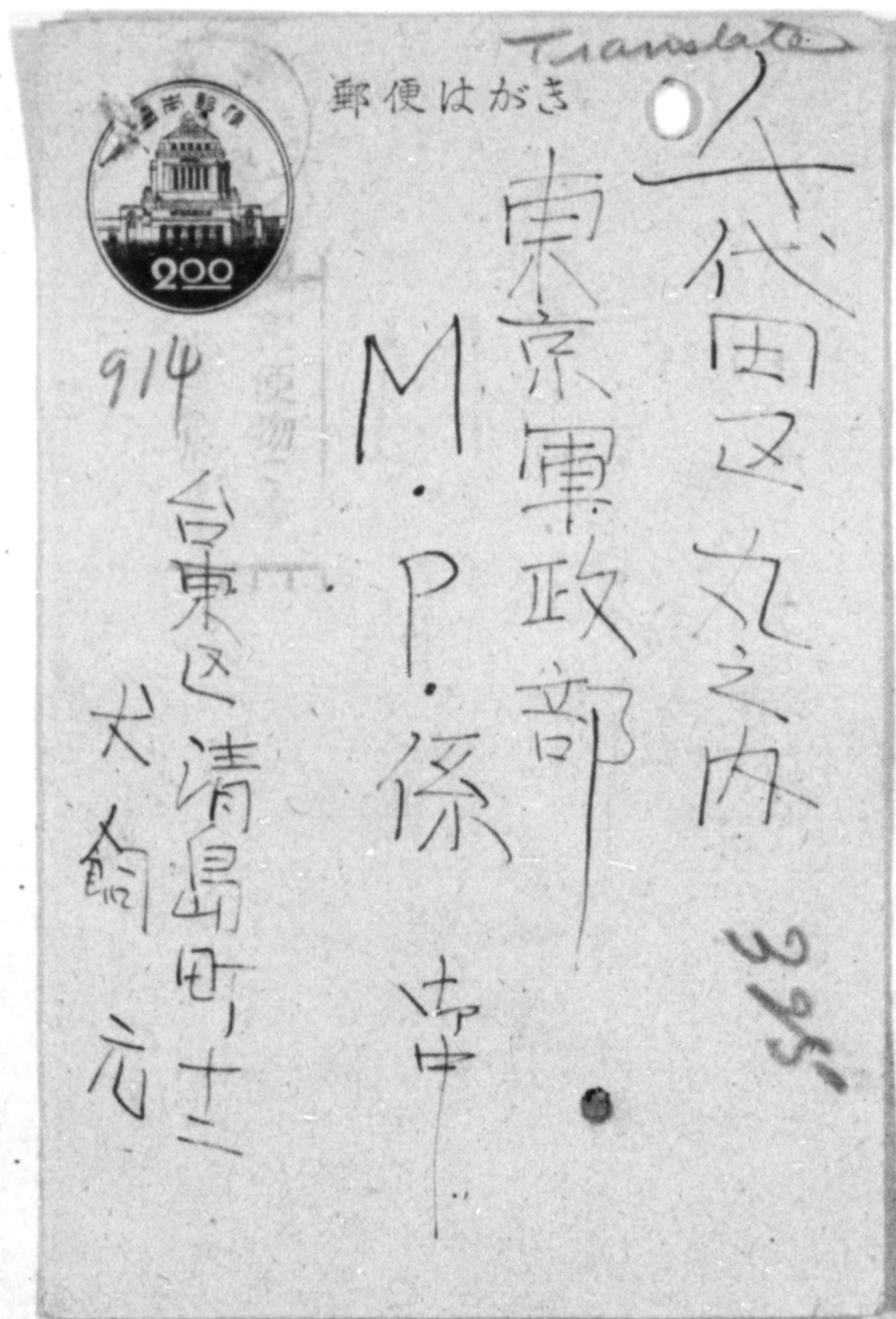



1. This is a reply in regards your communication dated 17 March 1950. After several attempts to get in touch with Public Health Section, P.H. Dept, Yokohama Municipal Office, Oimatsu-cho, Nishi-ku, Yokohama City, it was found that said office had been moved to Tokyo.
2. This Headquarters then called Yokohama Vice Squad, and learned that subject two EM, whose serial numbers are: RA 17 261 695, and RA 19 294 270, have already been interviewed by the Vice Squad and an attempt has been made to trace the girls who infected these men.
3. However if your office still wishes to see these men this will inform you that RA 17 261 695, is available. The other man RA 19 294 270, is away at Eta Jima School Command, and will not return this Headquarters for about four weeks.


