MEMORANDUM FOR: IMPERIAL JAPANESE GOVERNMENT

THROUGH : Central Liaison Office, Tokyo

SUBJECT : Telegraph Service for Approved Private Companies.

1. It is directed that the Japanese Ministry of Communications arrange to handle private telegraph messages sent by or addressed to the United Seamen's Service, Inc. as follows:

a. After censorship, messages addressed to UNSEASER, Yokohama, shall be delivered promptly by messenger to the United Seamen's Service, Inc., Building No. 2562, Yokohama.

b. Messages filed by the United Seamen's Service, Inc. will be sent in clear English.

c. Messages may be sent from Yokohama to the United Seamen's Service, Inc., 39 Broadway, New York, New York.

2. This account shall be in the name of the United Seamen's Service, Inc., 39 Broadway, New York, New York.
