SUBJECT : Release of Japanese Nationals

1. The Imperial Japanese Government is advised that the following named Japanese nationals have been released from Sugamo Prison:

2. The Imperial Japanese Government is further advised that upon apprehension of TANAKA, Masao and SHIRAO, Kunimitsu, the four (4) individuals referred to in paragraph 1 above will be made available on 24-hours' notice upon request of Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers.

3. The six (6) Japanese nationals named herein were ordered apprehended per Memorandum AG 383.6 (7 Jan 46)CIS, Subject: "Apprehension of Japanese Personnel" (SCAPIN 560), dated 7 January 1946.
