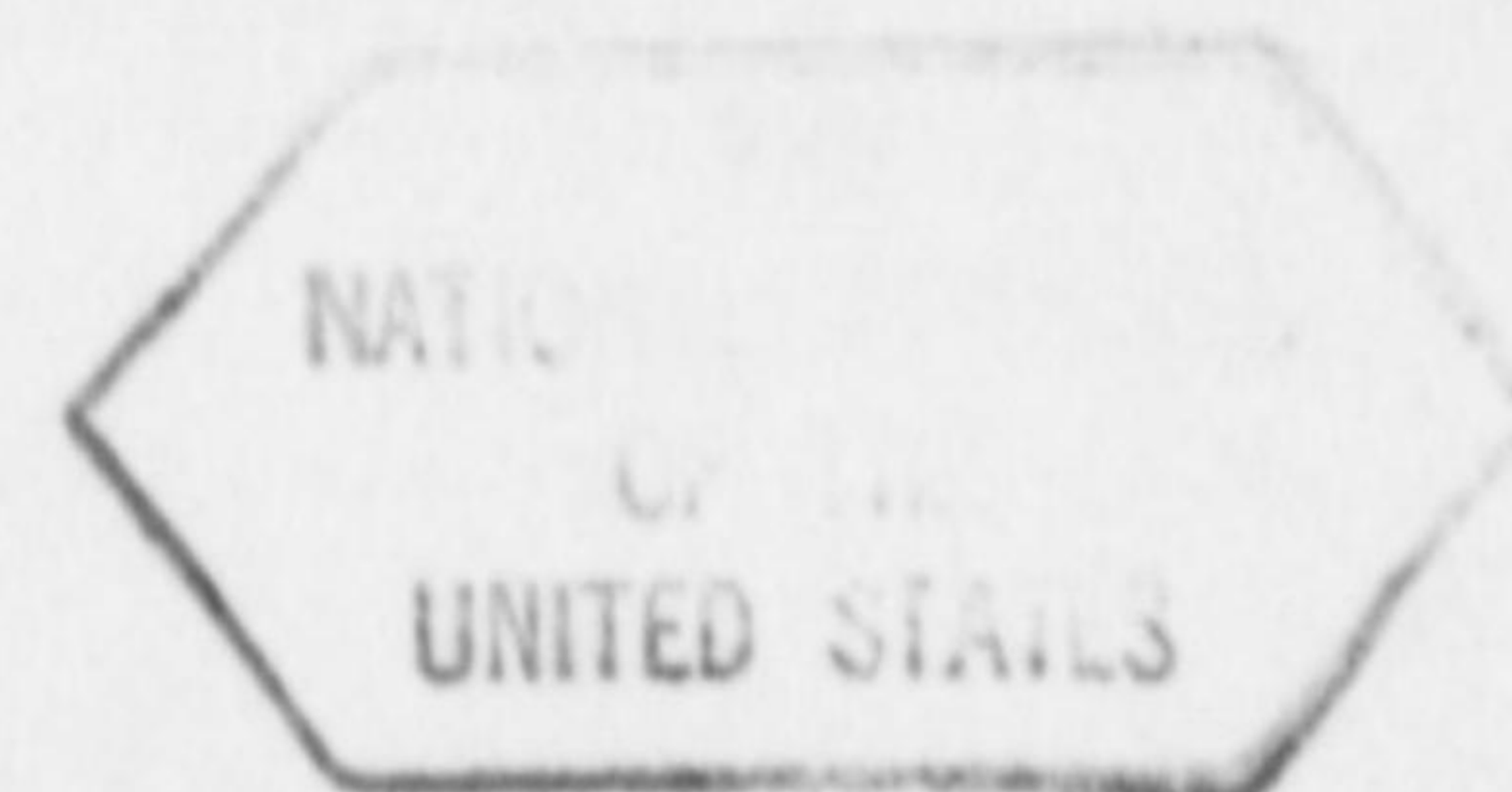

Remarks: SUBJECT: Ordinary School to be established at Camp Kurume.

1. On 4 December 1951, conference was held with Col Van Vliet, Adviser to the NPR Ordinary School for the purpose of reviewing the status of preparation for opening of said school on schedule.

2. As a result of this conference, it appears that the major obstacles remaining which must be removed before the school can be started, are:

a. The designation and movement of an Ordinary Battalion of school troops into Camp Kurume.

b. The appointment of at least two (2) additional officers as Advisers to plan and prepare the necessary instructional materials for the Weapons Instructors Course, and the Operation and Information Sergeants Course.

c. The granting of sufficient priority of translators work, in order to complete the translation of all instruction materials which are prepared.

3. The designation of the appropriate school troops battalion by GGHQ has been accomplished this date, (3rd Battalion, 11th Regiment, now located at Nakatsu).

4. (a) In order to alleviate the major obstacle named in 2b above, it is recommended that two (2) qualified officers be assigned to this duty immediately.

(b) The obstacle cited in 2c above, can be removed by adjusting the priority of work now being done by translator pool. Authority is requested to give the translations necessary for this school priority for the month of December, over all other materials to be translated, including Instruction Books.

1. In the capacity of Senior U.S. Adviser you will establish without delay an interim Ordinary School Center at Camp Kurume, and be prepared to conduct the following courses beginning on or about 1 January 1952:

Basic Ordinary Officer	60
Ordinary Light and Heavy Weapons NCO	60
Information and Operations NCO	60

2. An Officer Candidate School will be started at Camp Kurume after the 400 dopergees have been graduated from the Officer Training School at Camp Kurihama, on or about 6 February 1952. At that time, Major A. L. Burelbach, Major J. C. Williams, and the Japanese instructor personnel of the Officer Training Course, General Group School Center, will be transferred to Camp Kurume to supplement your staff.

3. Information regarding the organization of the school center, initiation of courses and preparation of programs of instruction is being prepared by General Group Headquarters and will be disseminated in the near future.
