SUBJECT: Repatriation of Korean Nationals

TO: See Distribution

1. Authority: Letter, GHQ, SCAP file AG 014.33 (22 Nov 48)GA, dated 22 November 1948, subject: "Repatriation of Korean Nationals".

2. GHQ, SCAP has approved the application for repatriation to Korea of the Korean nationals listed in attached inclosure. The number of dependents authorized for repatriation is listed opposite the head of each family in the inclosure.


3. The Korean nationals are being informed of the approval of their applications by the Japanese Government. They are also being instructed that travel to Sasebo will be at their own expense and that travel from Sasebo to Korea may be made on Shipping Control Authority Japanese Merchant Marine repatriation vessels returning illegal Korean entrants to Korea.

4. Subject repatriates must report for repatriation shipping within ninety days of the date listed on the inclosure.

5. Korean repatriates are to be permitted to convert Japanese yen for Korean won not to exceed ¥1,000 per individual. Authorized accompanied baggage will not exceed 4,000 pounds per family unit of household items.

6. It is desired that routine supervision and surveillance be given this repatriation.

1. Correspondence from the American Consul General, Yokohama, concerning false statements made by Masajiro Wada, and an affidavit by Wada admitting the false statements, are inclosed.
2. Under the provisions of Operational Directive Number 33, this headquarters, 14 May 1948, provost courts have exclusive jurisdiction over the offense of making false or misleading statements to a member of the occupation forces in a matter of official concern.
3. Attention is invited to the Consul General's statement that it appears that Masajiro Wada has expatriated himself by voting in a Japanese election in accordance with the applicable nationality laws of the United States and that he no longer possesses a valid claim to United States citizenship.

5. If investigation reveals that the false certificate was issued wilfully, it is suggested that the issuing official also be prosecuted; or if through negligence, that he be reprimanded.

Reference is made to my letter of November 14, 1947 concerning the issuance of false certificates on the part of Japanese officials to persons who are attempting to re-establish claim to American citizenship, and misrepresentations made by the applicants.

There is enclosed a statement made at this office on May 12, 1948 by Masajiro WADA (Address: Yanokuma, Kushimoto-cho, Nishimura-gun, Wakayama-ken) in which the applicant states that he voted for Town Mayor, Town Assemblyman, Prefectural Governor and Assemblyman in the Japanese elections of April, 1947, and admits that, in the application for passport which he executed at this office on December 4, 1947, he falsely stated that he had not voted in a political election in Japan. Records of this office indicate that, when confronted with evidence that he had voted, Mr. Wada stated that he had not realized that the local elections in which he voted were considered to be "political" elections, and that at the time of executing his application for passport he believed the statement that he had not voted in a political election to be true. However it is difficult to give credence to this statement, since at the time of his interview Mr. Wada submitted the certificate referred to below stating that he had not voted in any election in Japan.

There is also enclosed with this letter a certificate issued by Toyomatsu Kakamoto, Head of Kushimoto-machi,



Nishimuro-gun, Wakayama-ken together with three copies of a translation thereof, certifying that Masajiro Wada did not exercise his right to vote in any election.

It appears that Masajiro Wada has expatriated himself by voting in a Japanese election in accordance with the applicable nationality laws of the United States, and that he no longer possesses a valid claim to United States citizenship.

If the facts are considered to warrant, it is suggested that Wada be prosecuted in an appropriate court for having made false statements under oath before an American consular officer, and that full publicity be given to the prosecution in order to prevent similar cases in the future. If investigation reveals that the false certificate was issued wilfully it is suggested that the issuing official also be prosecuted; or if through negligence, that he be reprimanded.

1. Mrs. Margaret Breen Ehrhardt, age 64, an American by birth and marriage, is completely dependent upon the Japanese Government for her support. She is presently receiving relief from Kobe City and has sold most of her belongings to defray her living expenses.

2. Her husband, William, is confined to a home for chronically ill in New York. A daughter, Emily, lives at 35 W 67th Street, New York City. She has been employed since her return from Shanghai just before the war. Under the laws of New York State, if the husband is unemployed, the daughter is responsible for her mother's support but she has received no assistance from any of her family.

3. Securities are reported to be deposited in the daughter's name in the Hongkong Shanghai Bank in Shanghai. The release of some of these funds might be a solution.

4. This woman has never lived outside of Japan and culturally is predominately Japanese. Her repatriation might present a problem of the effect upon her.

5. Suggestions and clarification on this case are requested.

d. Japanese Tax Administration - Special emphasis has been placed on the collection of unpaid taxes. This drive has been directed mainly upon those persons and companies that owe more than 500,000 yen in unpaid taxes. As of 1 Aug 48 there was 62,346,181 yen remaining to be collected from those who owe 500,000 yen or more on 1947 - 48 taxes. Thus far there has been 4 prosecutions and 8 attachments. The Hirado tax office has a total of 6,567,462 yen delinquent taxes from those who owe 500,000 yen or more. All of these cases deal with coal mine operators. This tax office is not allowed to attach mining equipment.

e. Field Inspections - Field inspection trips are being made to several cities, towns and villages each month by members of the Legal and Government Section. Mainly field inspection trips are being made by members of the ken government, to assist city, town and village officials in government affairs. The field inspection trips of this section serve to check the effectiveness of ken officials.

f. Provost Marshal Liaison - To control ships in port and ships personnel, military police from the 34th Inf Regt have been placed on Detached Service to this team. A total of 5 MP's have been authorized but at present only 2 are on duty. When additional MP's are needed the Provost Marshal sends them to this headquarters.

1. Letters, GHQ, SCAP, file AG 014.33 (22 Oct 48)GA, dated 22 October 1948, subject: "Repatriation of Korean Nationals", and dated 23 October 1948, subject: "Repatriation of Korean Nationals".

2. GHQ, SCAP has approved the application for repatriation to Korea of the Korean national listed in attached inclosure. The number of dependents authorized for repatriation is listed opposite the head of each family in the inclosure.

3. The Korean nationals are being informed of the approval of their applications by the Japanese Government. They are also being instructed that travel to Sasebo will be at their own Shipping Control Authority Japanese Merchant Marine repatriation vessels returning illegal Korean entrants to Korea.

4. Subject repatriates must report for repatriation shipping within ninety days of the date listed on the inclosure.

5. Korean repatriates are to be permitted to convert Japanese yen for Korean won not to exceed ¥1,000 individual. Authorized accompanied baggage will not exceed 4,000 pounds per family unit of household items.

6. It is desired that routine supervision and surveillance be given this repatriation.

1. Authority: Letter, GHQ, SCAP, file AG 014.33 (26 Aug 48)GA, dated 26 August 1948, subject: "Repatriation of Korean Nationals".
2. GHQ, SCAP has approved the application for repatriation to Korea of the Korean national listed in attached inclosure. The number of dependents authorized for repatriation is listed opposite the head of each family in the inclosure.
3. The Korean nationals are being informed of the approval of their applications by the Japanese Government. They are also being instructed that travel to Sasebo will be at their own expense and that travel from Sasebo to Korea may be made on Shipping Control Authority Japanese Merchant Marine repatriation vessels returning illegal Korean entrants to Korea.
4. Subject repatriates must report for repatriation shipping within ninety days of the date listed on the inclosure.
5. Korean repatriates are to be permitted to convert Japanese yen for Korean won not to exceed ¥1,000 per individual. Authorized accompanied baggage will not exceed 4,000 pounds per family unit of household items.
6. It is desired that routine supervision and surveillance be given this repatriation.

SUBJECT: Deportation of Non-Korean National to South Korea

TO : Commanding Officer, Hyogo Military Government Team,
APO 317

1. Recent information from higher headquarters indicates that an eighteen year old boy by name of Steve Candele, born in Harbin, Manchuria in 1930 of a Spanish father and a British mother was recently deported from Japan, as an illegal entry, to South Korea. The boy is presently held in a detention camp at Pusan, Korea.

2. Brief history of the boy is as follows:

a. His parents died when the boy was four years old (1934) and the boy was taken in and brought to Kobe, Japan by the Japanese one KOGENAI HUMAKURA, residing at #18 Nagaki-cho, Sannomiya, Kobe, Japan in 1934. The boy lived in Kobe for 8 years and in 1942 went to Manchuria to work in a coal mine at Fuchun. In late 1947 or early 1948 he filtered down from Manchuria thru South Korea and smuggled into Japan. He was apprehended by the Japanese police as an illegal entrant into Japan and deported to South Korea.

b. The boy speaks only Japanese.

c. He has no living relatives to the best of his knowledge.

d. The boy says he has no friends except Mr. Kogenai Kumakura.

e. The boy desires to be permitted to live in Japan with Mr. Kogenai Kumakura.

3. In view of the above the Military Government authorities in Korea feel that the boy not being a Korean national was not properly deportable to South Korea. The authorities in Korea are placing the boy aboard the Bogata Maru sailing 15 April 1948 via the Ryukyus for Sasebo, Japan.

4. It is desired that an investigation be initiated to determine whether or not Mr. Kogenai Humakura is agreeable to an arrangement whereby Steve Candele will live with him in Kobe, and a report of your findings submitted to this headquarters at the earliest possible time.
