1. PSD is cognizant that in order to bring about the reorganization of the police forces within ninety (90) days, that careful planning and adherence to principles are essential, and that to dissipate time and effort is not desirable. A maximum utilization must and will be made, of all personnel and facilities to promote this program. 3

2. The reorganization cannot be accomplished without direct contact where necessary, or without observation of the effects on the new organization to detect unforeseen probabilities in law enforcement as a result of local control.

3. Field visits are necessary but will be held to the minimum. However, during the reorganization period the time and place requiring these visits cannot all be predicted and scheduled in advance. Many
