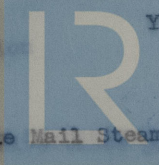
Dear Sirs,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 27th instant respecting the Steamer "IXIA" ex "HAGEN" and have to-day had pleasure in returning to you under separate cover the Midship Section and General Arrangement plans of this vessel. These plans have been examined and I have pleasure in stating that the scantlings and equipment indicated thereon are such as can be approved for the class 100A1. The scantlings should be verified by the Society's Surveyors and the requirements of the Rules for vessels not built under survey will require to be complied with. The Society's Surveyors at Hull have been instructed to give the matter the necessary attention.

Copies of the other plans mentioned by you will be forwarded to you as soon as the originals are received from the Hull Surveyors, and a communication has to-day been addressed to them asking that these plans be forwarded as soon as possible.
