The top news of the press is the speech in the americanJapanese club here of Amoassador Grow who recently returned
from America. The ambassador avowed at the beginning to be a
friend of Japan of many years and stated the improvement of the
American-Japanese relations as his life-work. The carrying out
is made especially difficult by the Japanese action in China,
which hit the American interests most severely. The american
public opinion is therefore ununimously against Japan. The
Ambassador demanded with unusual sharpness respect of the Mine
Powers Treaty and return to the open door, which Japan wishes
to concede to the other powers in China only in a completey
depreciated form.

The press described in its first commentaries the speech as a sharp refusal of the China-policy of Japan. The always proclaimed attempt of compromise with America thus began unfavourable for the Abe cabinet. Telegraphic reports will follow as soon as further effects become visible.
