SUBJECT: Amendment of T/O&E 30-500, 15 September 1948

1. C/N 1 from G-2 to G-3 through Sig and G-4 turn, subject as above, dtd 20 Oct 50 submits a draft letter to DA recommending an amendment of T/O&E 30-500. Signal concurs in G-2 recommendation.

2. G-4 (Lt Col Woodman) in conversation with Signal (Major Tune) was informed that there is no Sig Repair Tm in the T/O&E 11-500 series comparable to the type recommended in C/N 1. G-2 (Maj Titus) informed G-4 (Lt Col Woodman) that the dispersion of CIC units exists not only in the Far East but in all theaters of operations.

3. The recommendation contained in C/N 1 will establish two cellular units of Sig repairmen under the CIC T/O&E 30-500. This is desirable from a Troop Control standpoint as it will facilitate the organizing of CIC units under the T/O&E 30-500 series.

4. Recommend G-4 indicate concurrence by initialing C/N 2.

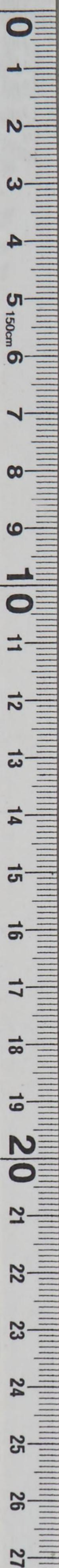

- b. C/S from G-2 to Sig, subject, "Repair and Maintenance of Radio Equipment", 26 Aug 50 (Incl 1).

2. The 441st CIC Det is organized under ref 1a supra which provides for a considerable number of T/O&E radios, but which does not provide for the personnel and/or equipment for the repair or maintenance of such T/O&E radios. The T/O&E was based on the concept that radio maintenance would be supplied from logistic support sources.

3. Ref C/N 2 to ref 1b supra in which the radio maintenance capabilities of the FEC Signal Office are indicated. It is felt that this type of signal support is not satisfactory since the AN/PRC-6 radios are designed for fixed installations and the AN/VRC-2 radios are mounted in vehicles. It is not feasible in either case to transport the radio sets from remote locations in Japan to Yokohama for repair and/or maintenance.

4. This office feels that action in this matter should be initiated to amend T/O&E 30-500. It has therefore prepared a draft letter to the DA (proponent-G-2) recommending an amendment of T/O&E 30-500 in consonance with the foregoing by the addition of radio maintenance teams together with repair and maintenance kits.

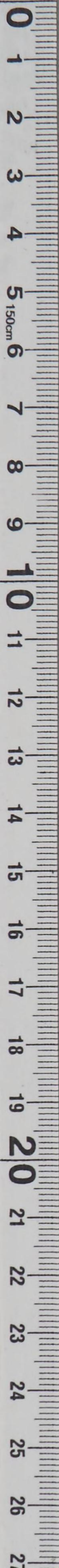

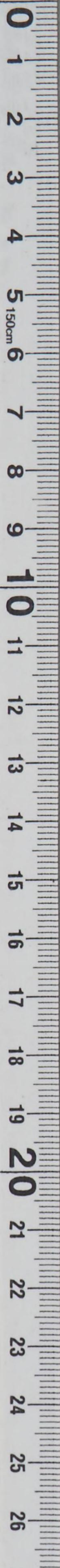

1. The CG Eighth Army has requested a table of distribution augmentation of 161 officers and 117 EM to carry out his civil affairs responsibility in North and South Korea (Msg G 26492 KGP, 22 Oct 50).
2. CINCPAC msg 66612 directed CG Eighth Army to establish the necessary staff and field organization for the accomplishment of this mission. He was informed that a PH&W TD organization consisting of approx 132 spaces had been approved in principle. The directive also informed CG Eighth Army that requests for additional spaces to accomplish his civil affairs mission were to be made to this headquarters in the normal manner.
3. There is an immediate requirement for a civil affairs or civil assistance augmentation of some sort within Eighth Army to carry out this mission.
4. Indications are that a UN Commission and a United Nations Korean Reconstruction Agency (UNKRA) will be established to relieve CINCUNC of the civil affairs mission, however there will be a considerable time lag between establishment of this commission on a working basis.
5. The CG Eighth Army has requested in msg 26492 that the augmentation of 278 spaces substitute for the 132 spaces being authorized for PH&W functions only. It is considered desirable that the civil assistance organization established in Korea cover the entire requirement and not one phase. The augmentation requested by CG Eighth Army appears to satisfy this need.
6. It is noted that the PH&W TD organization contains provision for assignment of either military or civilian personnel, to include UN recruited personnel. While the augmentation requested by Eighth Army does not include civilian spaces, it is considered that such UN personnel could appropriately be substituted for military personnel within the framework of the augmentation. Such UN personnel could later be transferred to UNKRA or other UN agency established in Korea.

 2. G-3 concurs in the necessity for organizing a unit to receive and train United Nations personnel. As indicated in letter (Inclosure 2), United Nations forces arriving in Korea are in varied stages of training and are scheduled to receive United States weapons, and considerable equipment. A period of orientation and familiarization with these weapons and equipment under American supervision is necessary.
 3. No US tactical unit scheduled to be stationed in the vicinity of Taegu is considered capable of administering and training incoming UN units without materially affecting the mission of the unit. It is further believed that other tactical units in Korea capable of such support will be engaged in planned operations, and therefore not available for such a mission.

2. 1. The technical services staff sections have commented on the tables for corresponding sections of Hq JLCOM. Their comments are attached.
2. A review of those portions of the proposed T/D submitted to G-4 reveals that the grades recommended for chiefs of staff sections are higher and the strengths recommended are far greater than those in T/O&E 110-200-1, Hq, Logistical Command (Type C). The only exception is the Chemical Section which agrees with T/O&E 110-200-1.
3. T/O&E 110-200-1 is designed to provide communications zone support to a combat force of approximately 400,000 men. It is considered to be the appropriate T/O&E for Hq, JLCOM. There appears to be no justification for augmentation of T/O&E 110-200-1 unless presented on the basis of meeting additional requirements to discharge missions within Japan. Augmentation for this purpose should not take the form of increased staff sections but should be provided in command agencies, for instance the Northern Command.
4. It was with this concept in view that G-4 concurred in obtaining Brigadier General Heiss to provide additional command supervision of Ordnance activities in Japan. While there is no objection to use of General Heiss as a staff Ordnance officer in addition to his command functions, G-4 does not concur in authorizing General Officer spaces for Chiefs of Staff Sections in Hq Japan Logistical Command or in an augmentation of those sections unless more specific justification is presented than has been done in the basic request.
5. It is recommended that Hq, Japan Logistical Command be organized on the basis of T/O&E 110-200-1 and that any augmentation required to discharge missions in Japan be in the form of command agencies.
