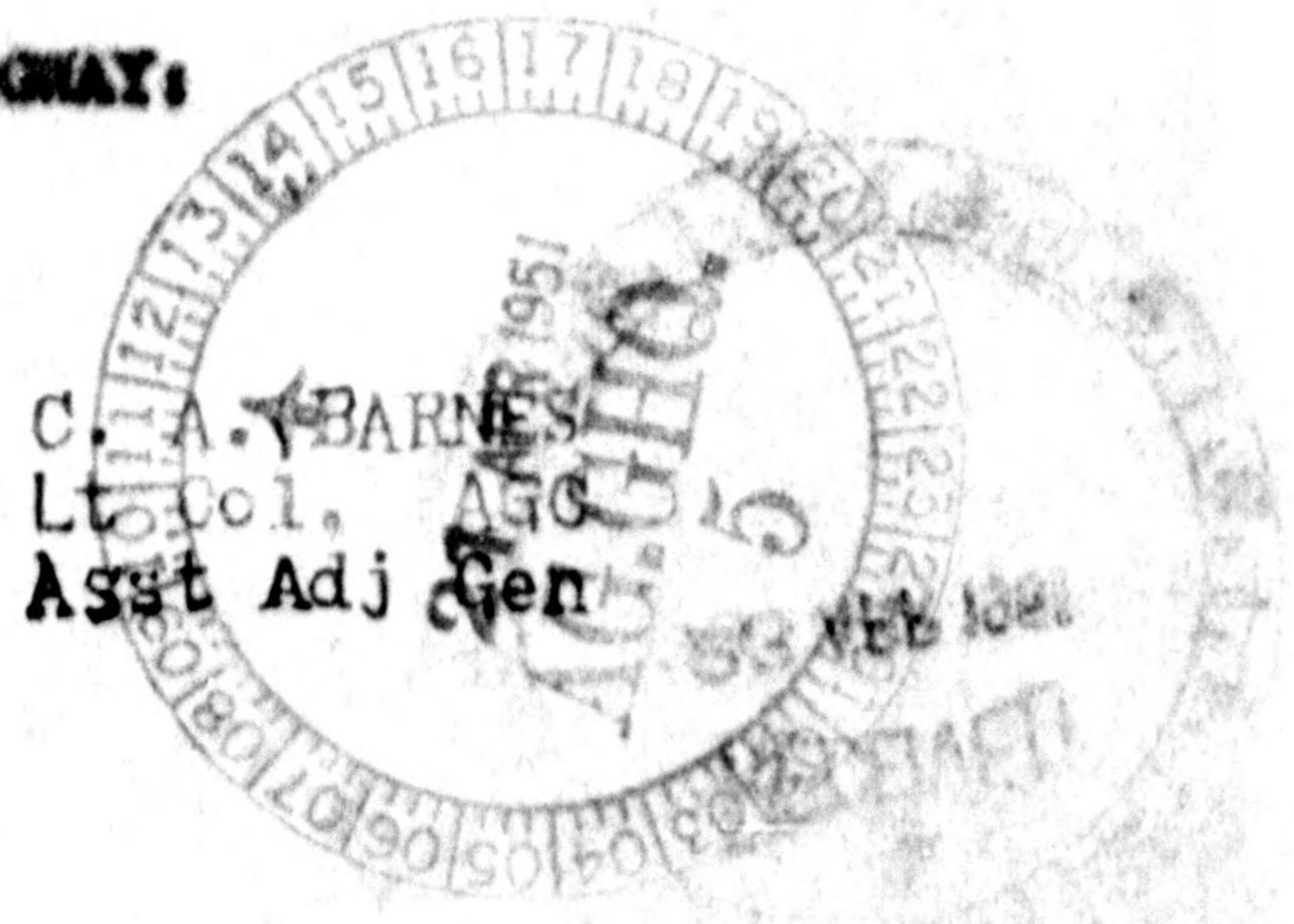

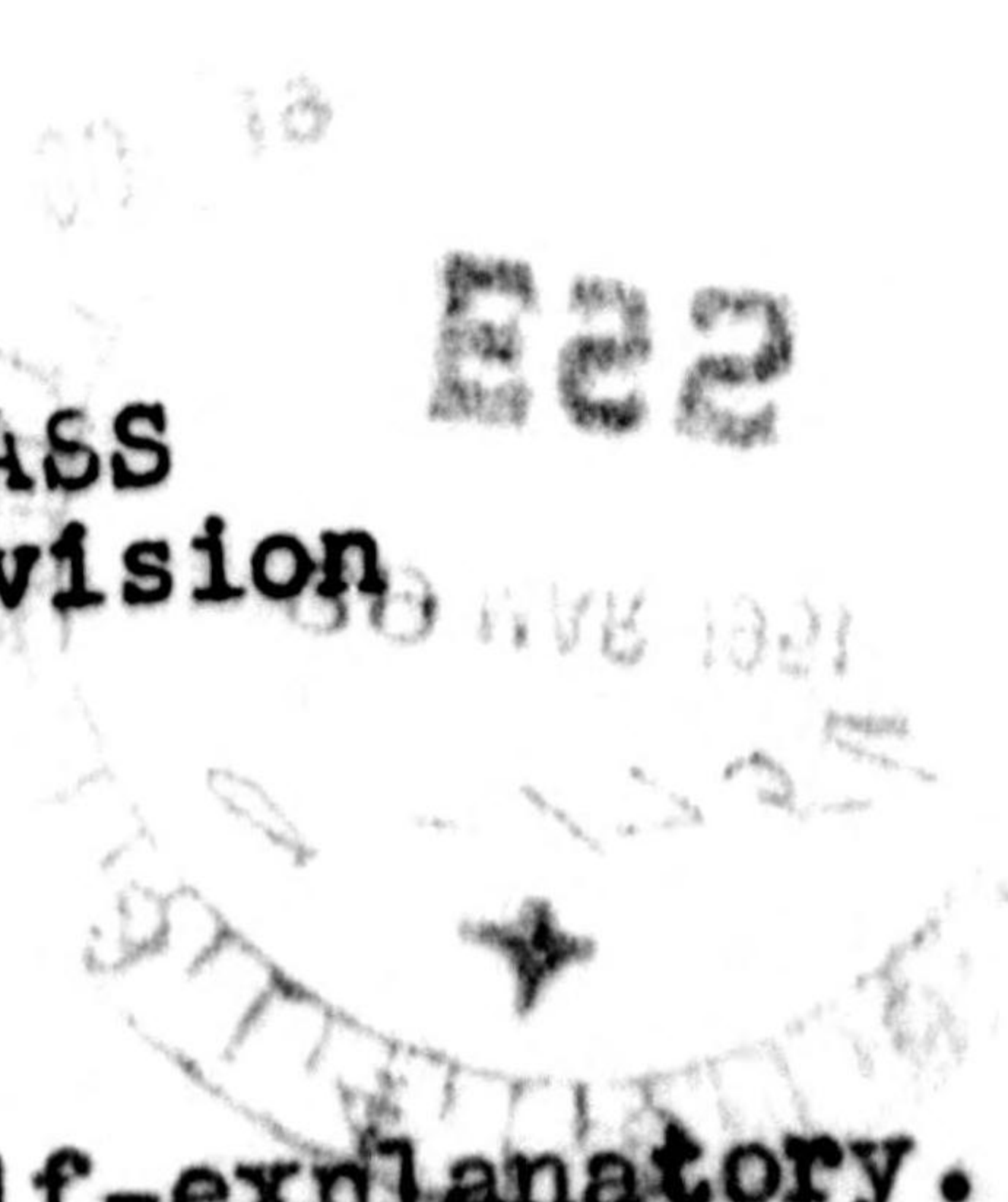

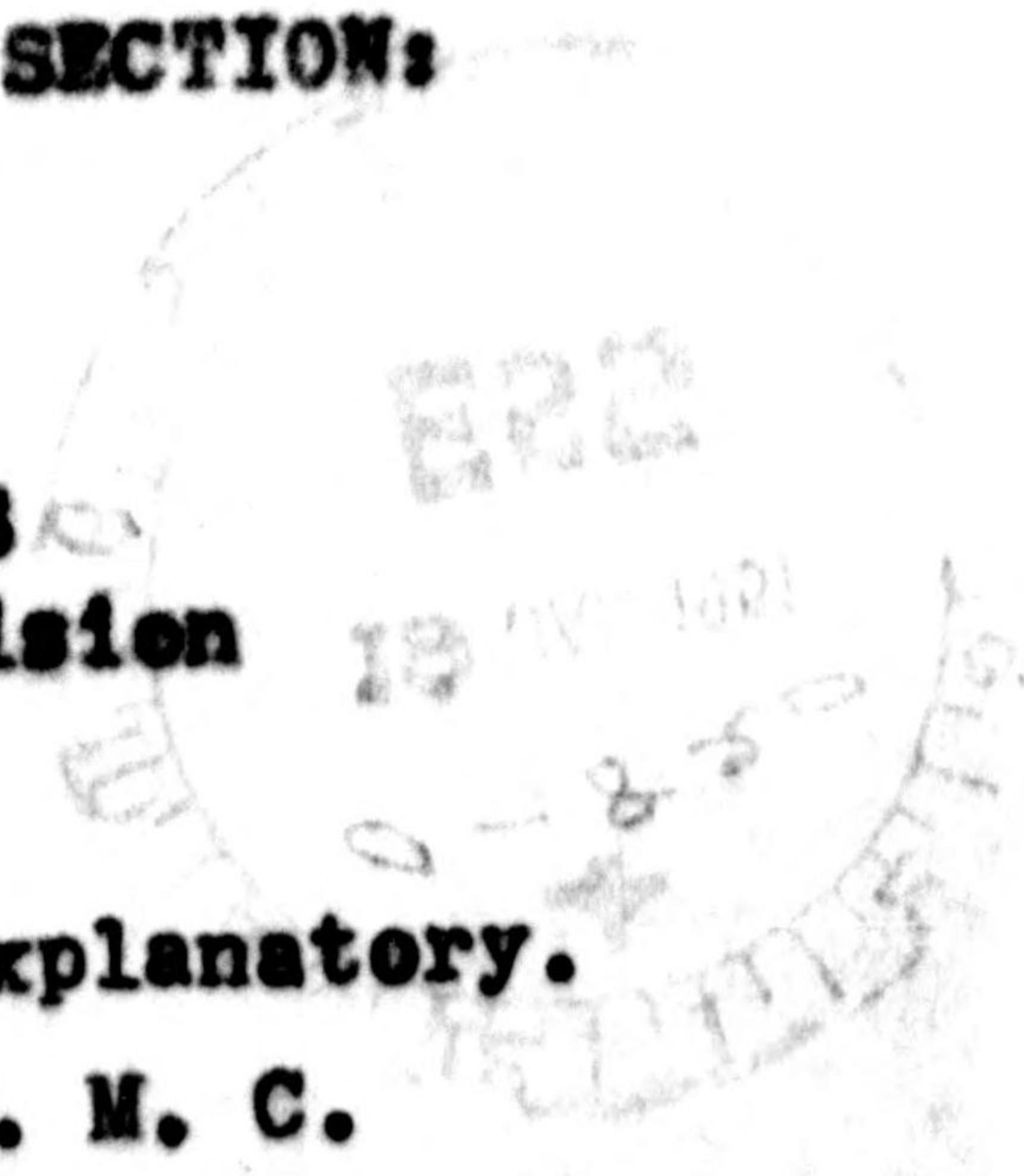

5. This headquarters recommends that the thirty six (36) items listed in paragraph 4b above be placed in authorized use with the Tokyo Ordnance Depot, for the following reasons:

a. This equipment is now located in Tokyo. Disapproval would involve movement to Kyushu at the expense of Occupation Forces.

b. All items were originally listed to be scrapped by the Japanese Government, but were deleted by this headquarters.

c. When this Arsenal (Hita Factory) was in operation, this equipment was used to produce wooden rifle stocks. During the destruction of special purpose machinery, attachments to this equipment were destroyed rendering it unserviceable. However, Ordnance technicians have stated that they could use the equipment by casting new parts.

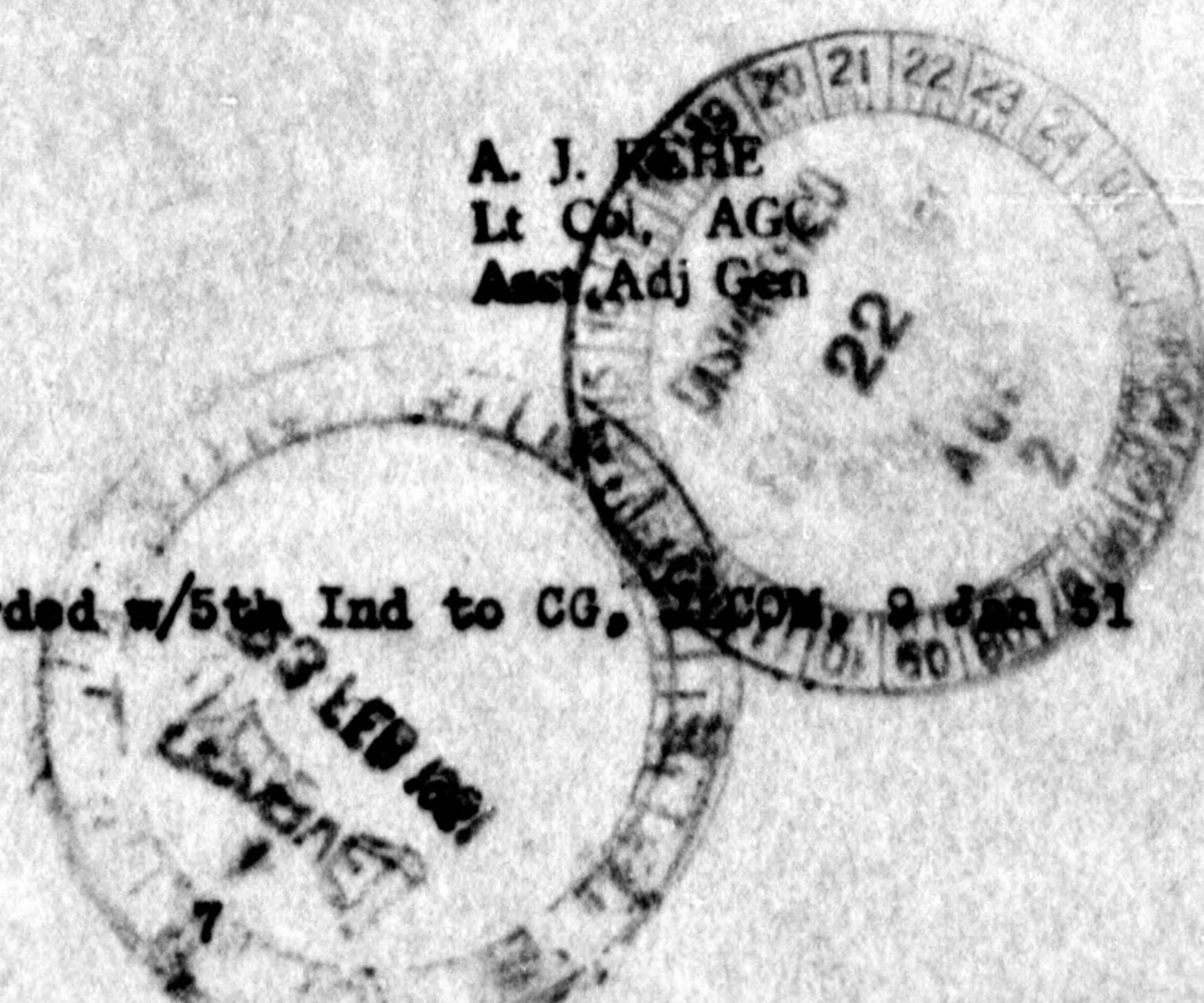

5. This headquarters recommends that the thirty six (36) items listed in paragraph 4b above be placed in authorized use with the Tokyo Ordnance Depot, for the following reasons:

a. This equipment is now located in Tokyo. Disapproval would involve movement to Kyushu at the expense of Occupation Forces.

b. All items were originally listed to be scrapped by the Japanese Government, but were deleted by this headquarters.

c. When this Arsenal (Hita Factory) was in operation, this equipment was used to produce wooden rifle stocks. During the destruction of special purpose machinery, attachments to this equipment were destroyed rendering it unserviceable. However, Ordnance technicians have stated that they could use the equipment by casting new parts.
