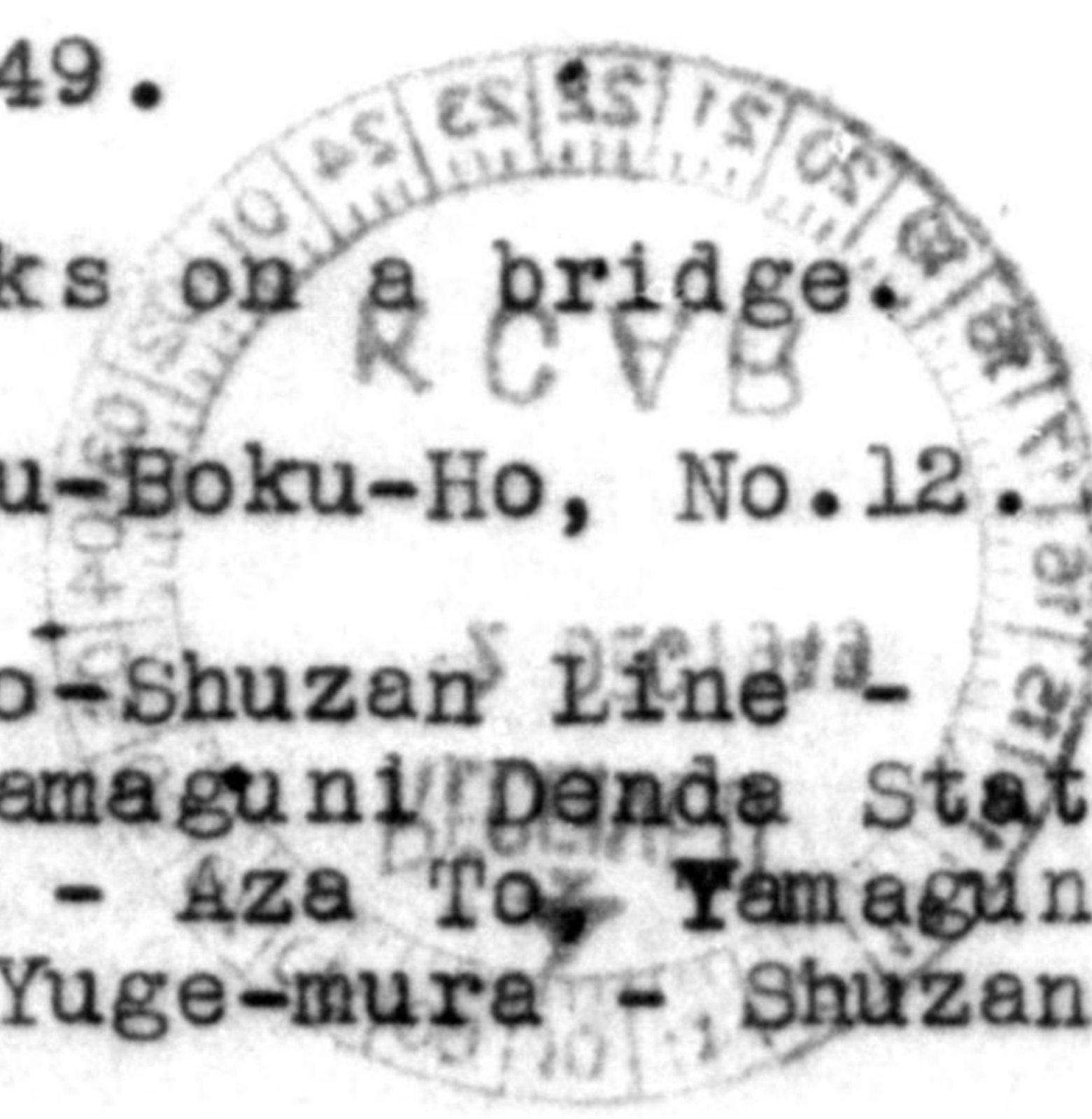

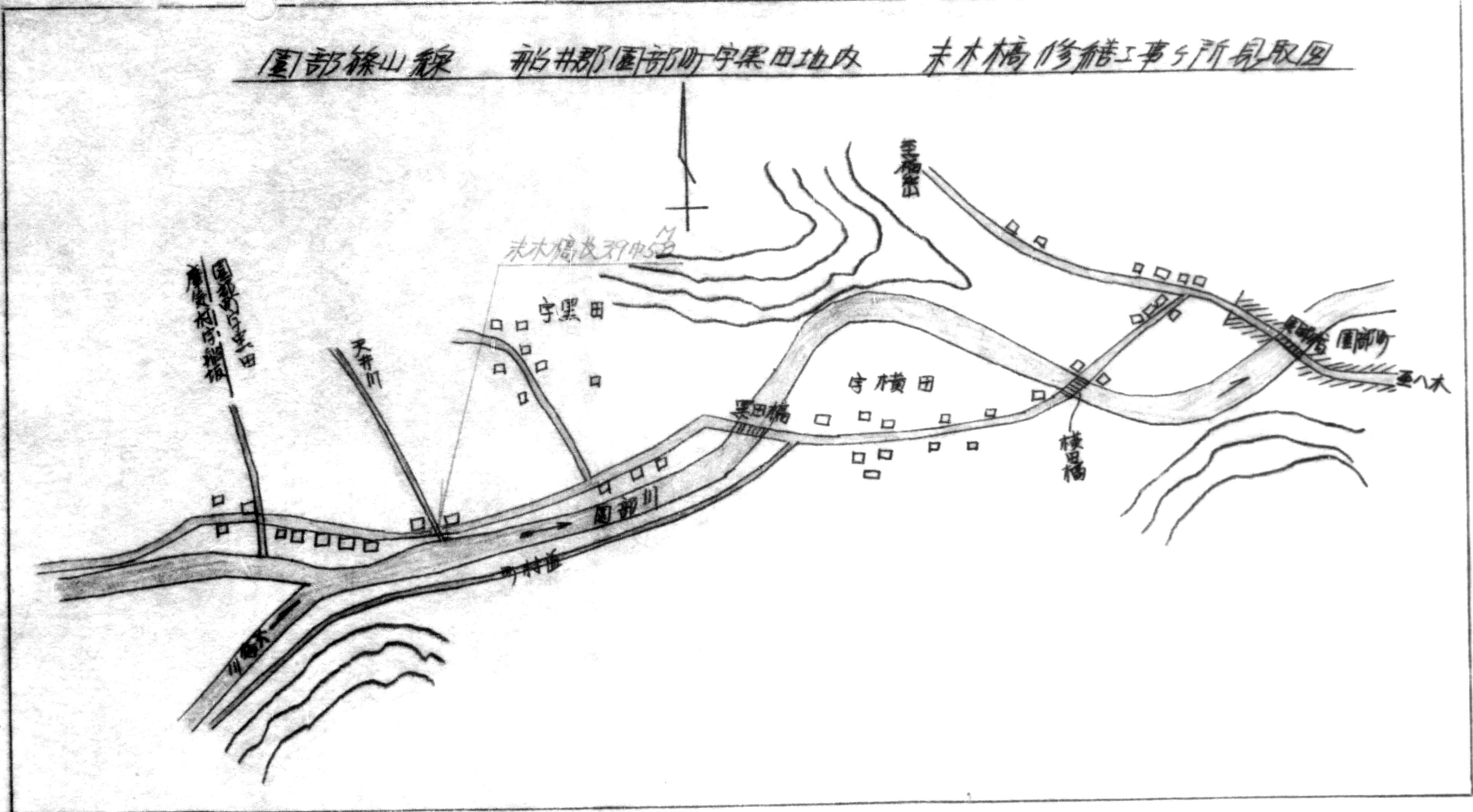

1. Place: Aza Toyoda, Takahara-mura, Funai-gun.
 2. Route: National High Way No.18 Line.
 3. Restriction: Traffic of all vehicles is prohibited, Men & horses are allowed to pass.
 4. Term: From Dec 2 to Dec 11 ten days.
 5. Reason: For Repairing works of Takaya-gawa Bridge & Toyoda Bridge.
 6. Work Description: Named Sono-Gi-Ho No.9410, bridge repairing works.
 7. Remarks: No.1 Roundabout way - From Suchi Station of Suchi-cho, Funai-gun passing along Hinokiyama-Suchi-Line to Hinokiyama Bridge.
No.2 " - From Mikka-ichi of Suchi-cho, Funai-gun, passing along Suchi-Shimoyama Station-Line and through Aza Toda, Takahara-mura, taking village road reach to Government Bus Line Tanba-Takahara.

1. Attention is invited to unnumbered Memorandum, dated 19 July 1949, Headquarters, Eighth Army, addressed to Civil Information Officers with four inclosures covering the above subject.

2. It is desired that a close check be made as to steps being taken to educate the general public in the changes and the methods to be employed by police agencies in enforcing the law after 1 November 1949.

3. Local police and branches of National Rural Police should be encouraged to embark on a vigorous publicity program to bring the provisions of the amendment to the attention of all concerned. Inexpensively prepared materials might well be distributed by these agencies to numerous groups, associations, and organizations for discussion purposes.

4. Team Civil Information Offices should participate in the program only in an advisory capacity.

SUBJECT: Legal Reference Material in SCAP CI&E Libraries

TO : Commanding General
I Corps
APO 301
Attention: Civil Affairs Section

1. For some months past, one comment or item has been recurring in conferences between the Chief of Legal-Government Section, this headquarters, and Japanese lawyers, court officials and procurators. The item of comment or query coming from the Japanese has been, "What can be done to obtain additional American law books for SCAP CI&E libraries? We visit them frequently but their offerings are too general in nature to be of much assistance. Most of us have had training in a law code more closely resembling European continental methods than Anglo-American process. The large number of laws enacted by recent sessions of the Diet have a distinctly Anglo-American flavor. We would very much appreciate access to court decisions, textbooks, case books or digests on American court practice."

2. A brief survey of legal publications available in Osaka, Kobe, and Kyoto SCAP CI&E libraries was conducted. It was found that the books are of a rather general nature, e. g. "Digest of International Law" (eight volumes), "Philosophy of Law", "Law - A Century of Progress", two volumes on criminal law, three on procedure, and one on constitutional law. The "Harvard Law Review" appears to be the only legal periodical regularly received. There were a number of books which may be classified collateral to law, such as government, government administration, biographies of leading judges, etc. Each of the three libraries had about the same material available to the Japanese.

3. It is the opinion of this headquarters that a number of textbooks dealing with specific phases of legal training in the U. S.

would constitute a definite asset to the furthering of legal education in Japan, if the books could be made available through SCAP CI&E libraries. Further, that recognized digests, of which "Corpus Juris" is an example, might well be added to the libraries in cities where a high court is located.
