Ourad CX 64225 of 2 Oct 48, CG USAFIK (Coulter sends for Muccio) rad ZPOL 1795 (Seoul Mission Nbr 168, Oct 30) and Department of State radio (relays message from Paris sent Department DELGA 506 Oct 28, signed Marshall, for Joint Chiefs of Staff and Muccio, Seoul as Paris Nbr 4) refer.

In connection with remarks on the training of Korean forces contained in Department of State DELGA 506 Oct 28, the following comments of CG USAFIK are furnished for your information:

"Despite interruption of training caused by recent revolt, it is considered here that Korean Constabulary can reach a satisfactory state of training by 31 December. This revises our previous estimate of completion of training by 1 December. The Korean Coast Guard and national police are considered adequately trained in their functions. Plans here provide for rapid and aggressive program of recruitment, training and indoctrination of constabulary troops. The recent revolt constituted a test of the loyalty of the constabulary as a whole, and revealed that the overwhelming mass of troops can be relied upon to support the govt. Constant measures are being taken to weed out subversive elements. This is a problem that must be

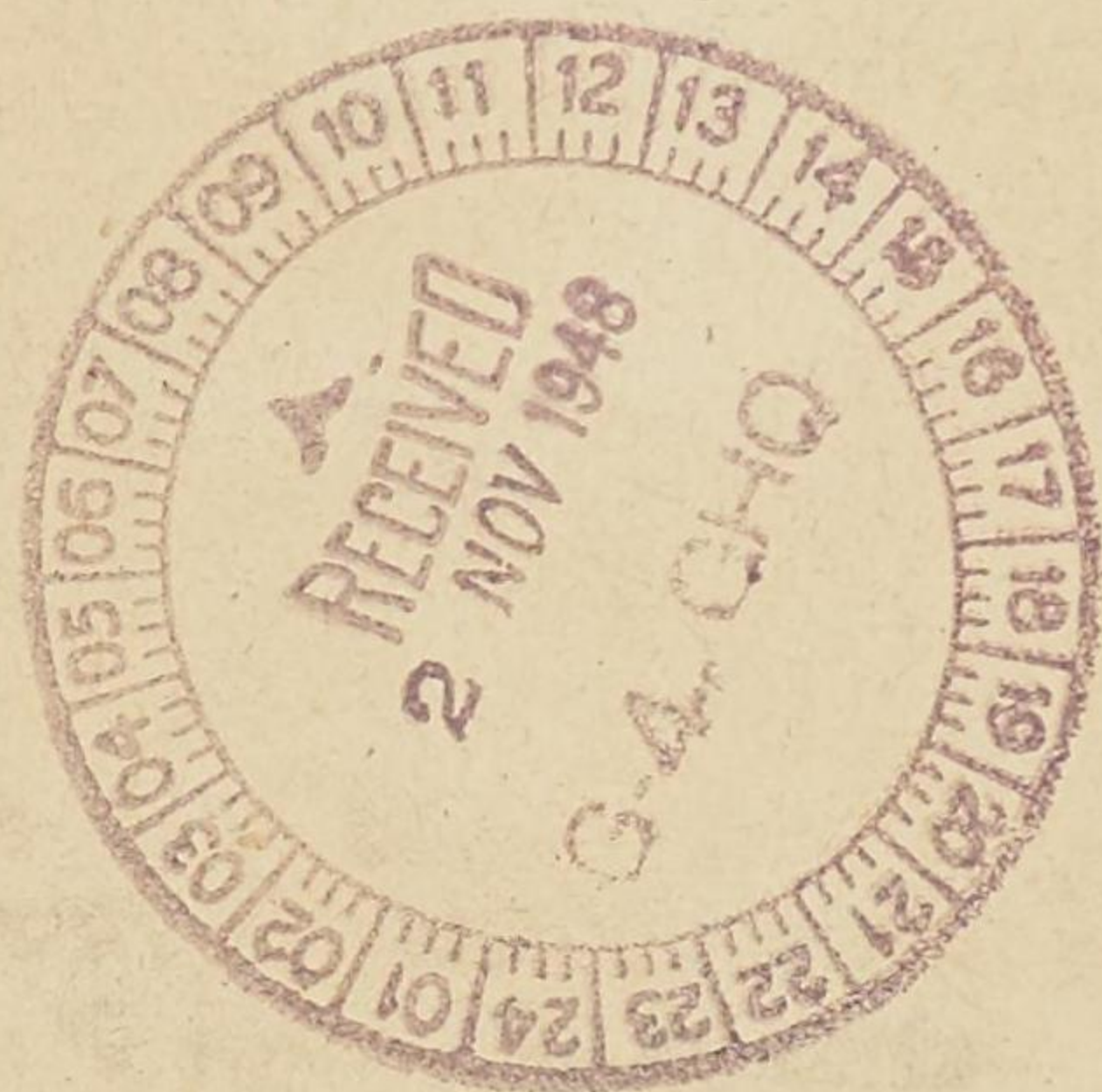
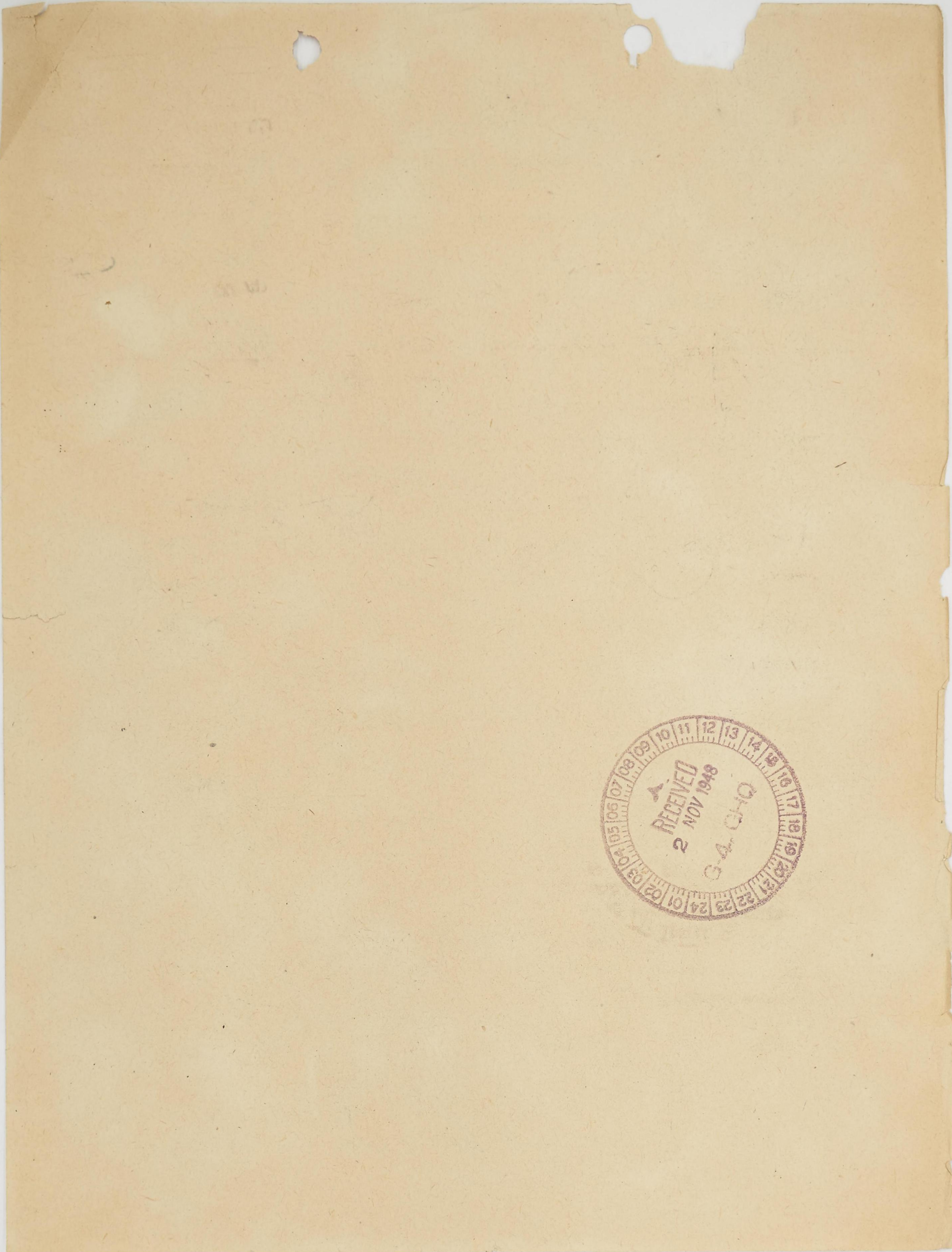
