貴之票。一分倒蓋。余生平所見。連此僅四枚。二分倒  
蓋。生平所見。連此僅二枚。二枚之外。知其存在世間  
而未之見者。亦不過三四枚。實比所謂四寶者為稀  
有。特集郵家不如四寶之重視耳。余已不惜重價得  
之。

萬壽小字二分九分複蓋。

紅印花小二分倒蓋而兼複蓋。此為紅印花四寶之一。

名不如小一元之大。而實際之罕貴則過之。英美

華郵大王。皆各有小字一元。而獨缺此一寶。其難得可知矣。此一寶爲許伯明廳長購去。

二元宮門倒印下連邊紙。此票久不來華矣。今竟來此一枚。惜標價爲四十五鎊。照彼時匯兌。約合千元。故無人能購之。

前清藍色欠資半分票。四方連直縫無齒。此票雖見司各得目錄。而未標價。人皆不知其罕貴。余八年以來覓之久矣。卒未一見。心知其異常罕貴。今日到手。故不計價值如何。決不放過也。

以上特記其罕貴之變體。其尋常變體尙多。姑從缺略。

### 路市展覽會臨時郵局紀念戳詳記

轟動全國之中華全國路市展覽大會。已於九月十五日。公开展覽。記者得郵局消息。謂將有臨時郵局一處。參與盛會。以便遊客就近投寄郵件。並啓用紀念郵戳。凡在臨

時郵局寄信者。皆以紀念戳消印。記者聞之。曷勝狂喜。即備郵件數事。於當日下午五時。驅車前往。雖塗程遙遠。然一越霞飛路。環境清靜。脫乎俗塵。胸襟爲之一豁。約七時至貝當路。遙望高聳大樓。轟立雲霄。電炬燦爛奪目。蓋已達目的地矣。至大門購券入內。惟新雨初霽。且甬道又未竣工。泥濘顛跛。大有蜀道難行之歎。至跳舞廳。進高大牌坊之場門。第見遊客並不擁擠。各國陳列之各種汽車。鱗次櫛比。與吾國各省市之照片模型圖表等。大有研究價值。記者急欲探訪臨時郵局所在地。走馬看花。無心瀏覽。且會場廣大。若詳加觀摩。恐非窮數日之力不能盡也。忽聞操國語之鎔造鋼條有聲電影已開幕。聲調宏亮。正擬駐足一觀。回首已見臨時郵局。當往該局詢問。視局內佈置樸素而雅致。含有美術風味。局長曹君和靄可親。有問必答。並云紀念戳因時間關係。趕製不及。約明後日可竣。現暫以木質戳臨時代之。(A圖)僅蓋郵件上。而郵票仍以平常郵戳消印。記者意臨時郵局。復用臨時紀念戳。

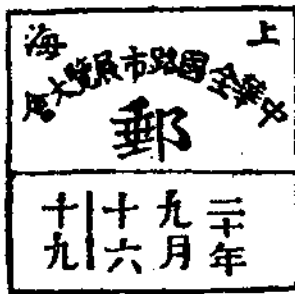

總局也。記者一見正式紀念戳。喜不自禁。忙將掛號及平信片等投諸櫃上。蒙曹君親自蓋戳。極為精細。明晰異常。視掛號執據。列號由十二號起。其間相差祇一號。否則可與昨日執據聯號也。且云其臨時木戳之命運。祇一日有半。現不能並用。須立時呈還總局取消矣。記者謂該戳雖壽命短促。而所蓋之郵件。以物稀為貴。極有歷史之價值也。相與一笑而別。聞臨時郵局辦公時間。每日下午三時至十時止。郵件在七時內寄交者。可當日發出。逾時須待至次日再發。展覽會公開時定為三星期。至十月二日閉幕云。

## SOCIETY AFFAIRS.

The annual general meeting of the Chinese Philatelic Society was held in the premises of the Bankers' Club on the 27th September, 1931, at 3 p.m. The proposal by the Chairman Mr. M. D. Chow that the re-election of Committee for the current year be waived and that the present Committee be requested to remain to carry on their duties as usual was unanimously passed by the members.

The "Chinese Philatelic Society Monthly" will be three years old in November. The members suggested that a special number in commemoration of the occasion be issued, and that in this issue more important articles were to be published and outside contributions to be called for. But owing to the lack of time, which does not permit the writing of original or the translation of foreign reading matters, as well as to the fact that the Editor-in-Chief Mr. M. D. Chow is going to remove to his new residence in December, it has now been decided that the 1st and 2nd issues of Vol. IV will be published in one double number, special attention being directed to the compilation of its contents, especially reading matters in English which is to be expanded to more than 8 pages. For single copies, this commemorative number will be sold at increased price, but for advance subscriptions for whole year, no increase in charge will be made.

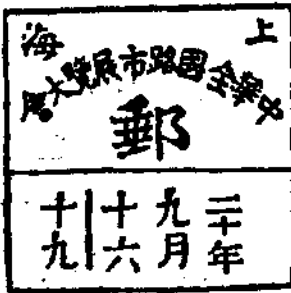
## COMMEMORATIVE POSTAL CHOP FOR THE "GOOD ROADS EXHIBITION".

The "Good Roads Exhibition of the Republic of China" was inaugurated on the 15th September, 1931. A temporary branch office was opened at the place, and a special postal chop in commemoration of the

exhibition was to be used. I went to post a few letters and to cancel some stamps to order but was told by the officer in charge that the lack of time had prevented the special chop from being ready in time. A wood-cut provisional postal chop, oblong in shape as per Figure A, bearing the inscription meaning "Temporary Post Office for the Good Roads Exhibition of the Republic of China" was used in addition to the ordinary postal cancellation. This chop has been in use for only one and a half days. In the afternoon of the day following, i.e., the 16th September, the formal brass chop, as per Figure B, came into use. It is square in shape, with the name "Shanghai" in two Chinese characters on the two upper corners, and a horizontal line which means "Good Road Exhibition of the Republic of China". The large character in the centre is "郵" (postal), and the date of year, month, day and hour is given in the section below. The square chop was daily used for 3 weeks during the Exhibition, and is nothing uncommon, but the oblong chop is considered a rarity, as the period covered is so short that very few people know its existence, and only a few letters are found to bear this chop.

### ERRATA.

We regret to have to notify our readers of the serious blunder that was made in the last paragraph of the Article under the title "An account of the issue of special envelopes in commemoration of the inauguration of Europe-Asia Air-mail Service", as appeared on page 3 of the double number 34-35 of our Monthly. In every case where the word "front" or its equivalent was used, it should be corrected to read "back" and *vice versa*. For instance, the first two sentences should read "On the *back* of these envelopes, a round embossed seal was to be chopped. Through the ignorance of the printer, some of these chops were erroneously put on the *front*" and so forth.
