On nearly all lawns there are unsighly bare apole under the shade of frees, which have builded all efforts to get late grass, but with this mixture there need be no further difficulty. It is a combination of the dwarf growing, evergen varieties, which in their wild or natural close are to be found growing in the woods or other shellared and chaded epots. Ground that has been densely shaded by frees is frequently "nour" and it the drahoage is delective it is apiliobe covered with mosa and coarse grasses. In such ease an application of slacked flute, at the rate of one bushel to each 1000 square feel, or 40 bushels to the acre, is an excellent corrective and sweetener, but the moss abould be lizal removed by the use of a sharp roke.
