Alexandre and Co.'s Universal Church Harmoniums.

The objects gained in these instruments are cheapness, simplicity, and power, and they are especially adapted to Churches and Chapels. They have none of the ordinary stops, excepting the Tremolo and Expression, but have the Knee Swells, bass and treble, and a Grand Jeu for the heel, which enables the performer to increase and diminish the power without taking the hands off the keys. The simplicity of playing will therefore be easily understood.

- No. 1.—Size: 3 feet 6 inches by 1 foot 6 inches. 3 feet high. Two rows of vibrators, similar to Flute-Cor Anglais, Clarinette and Bourdon. One row always on, and the other added by a Grand Jeu worked by the heel. Knee pedals like the drawing-room model. Expression and Tremolo stops. Oak case. Price 18 guineas.
