After Princeton and three law degrees, he sought ways to give back - as a teacher, as an environmental attorney, as a rabbi, and through politics as a member of the Youngstown, Ohio Board of Education. He has fought a state takeover trapping minority students in a cycle of failure, fought fracking, and mounted successful legal efforts to hold public officials accountable. Dario's experience in local politics has made clear to him that nationwide system change is necessary to give Americans greater say and an equal chance at success.
