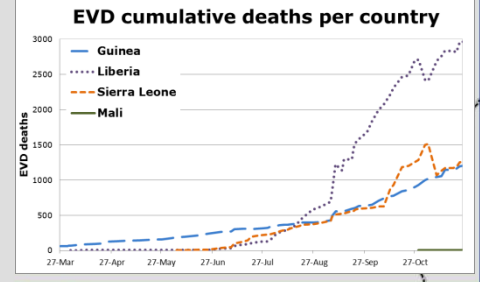
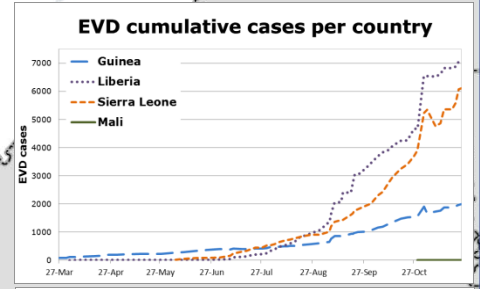
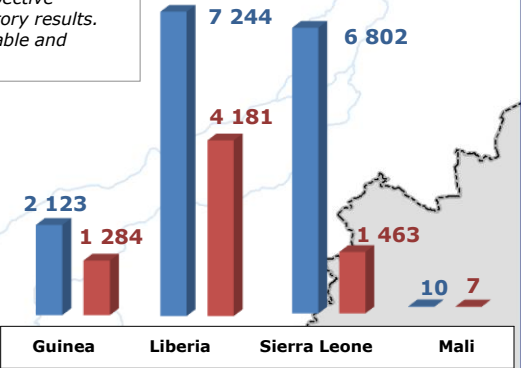


1 December 2014: West Africa - Ebola Virus Disease (EVD) Outbreak

SITUATION

- WHO has reported a total of 16 205 reported cases of Ebola virus disease (EVD) and 6 944 deaths as of 28 November 2014.
- The number of new reported cases seems stable in Guinea, stable or declining in Liberia, and may still be rising in Sierra Leone. The total number of cases reported in Sierra Leone since the beginning of the outbreak may soon exceed the numbers reported from Liberia, according to WHO.
- UNMEER aimed to isolate up to 70% of EVD cases and safely bury 70% of EVD-related deaths by 1 December.
- The three countries of Guinea, Sierra Leone and Liberia reported more than 80% of registered contacts associated with known cases of EVD were traced, although the lower average number of contacts registered per case suggests that contact tracing is still challenging in areas of intense transmission.
