

4. Circumstances : When policeman KOBAYASHI Toshimitsu of Honden Police Station was on his beat near No.1,101 Shimo Komatsucho at about 9:50 p.m. Sept. 12, he found 2 suspicious men put into something like a paper from the crevice in the glass-window of EBINA Masahiro. As it seemed to him that they were in possession of papers inside the trousers pockets, he questioned EBINA, as the consequence of which it was disclosed that they had distributed handbills derogatory to America as below-mentioned, subsequently RI was arrested at the time and place (aforesaid) as a strong suspect.

The contents of handbill are as follow:-

"SEE THE FACTS! THE LAST MOMENT OF THE AMERICAN AGGRESSIVE FORCES!

"Now it becomes an open secret that approximately 10,000 unmarried Koreans, aged ranging from 16 to 45, are being subjected to the military training coercively being threatened by the bayonets of American soldiers. A great number of them attempt to escape at the risk of their lives. Being driven into the southern strip of land, both American aggressive forces and Syngman Rhee's puppet forces, in spite of their continued defeats, are struggling to rise up. If anyone engages in firm work, he may be taken away by them after being threatened by the bayonet to Japan with only the clothes on his back, without notifying his families of it.

"At the training institute they are given no freedom of conversation or leave, and it is said that they are given nothing except their rations. No doubt that they will be sent to the battle front soon as the cannon-fodders. What are we to know by these facts?

Subject : Reaction of the Arrest of Two Communists,
the Suspects of Imperial Ordinance No. 311,
by the Honden Police upon Casual Laborers.

Summary : In protest against the arrest of the said ~~the~~ Tokyo
Federation of Civil Engineering and Construction W.U.
members are now taking united action, demanding the
release of the two.

Details:

- 1) As already reported, in the grey of the morning, on September 16, the Honden Police Station arrested YANAGI Kensuke, a Korean communist, chairman of Honden Employment Security Office branch, Tokyo Federation of Civil Engineering and Construction W.U. and ITAKURA Yuko, a member of Executive Committee of the same as the suspects of the violation of Imperial Ordinance No.311.
- 2) At about 5 p.m., Sept. 16, some 10 people led by the ICP members Yamazaki, Watada, Mototsuchi, Hoshino, etc., called at the police station several times, demanding "the explanation of the arrest" and "the release of the arrested", but they were turned back, having heard the police only explaining the reason of the arrest and refusing to give any further details.
- 3) The dissatisfied communists and their followers distributed the hand-bills propagandizing as follows:

Save (橋) (秋倉)
Save Yanagi and Itakura.

Listen ! We day laborers, to cover the unemployment of once a week, have to sell our blood, pick up rubbish, or even go to such a work as endangers our lives Yanagi and Itakura who had been fighting bravely, under these tormenting circumstances, at the head of us day laborers, in protest against the unemployment, were unduly arrested at 4 a.m. Sept. 16, at their homes.

To look on this with folded arms means our unconditional surrender to the unemployment which will be feared to happen more frequently in the future.

Let us stand up resolutely against this attack of our enemy and fight for the immediate release of our friends.

1. Let us oppose against the unemployment notebooks being taken away.
2. Let us oppose against the pressure upon laborers.
3. Let us demand the immediate release of Yanagi and Itakura.
4. Start a fund collection campaign for the relief of the two !
