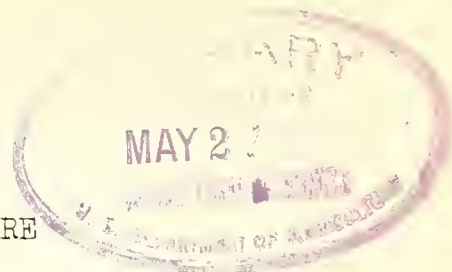

STOCKS OF LEAF TOBACCO OWNED BY DEALERS AND MANUFACTURERS

APRIL 1, 1937.

Stocks of leaf tobacco owned by dealers and manufacturers in the United States and Puerto Rico amounted to 2,276,038,000 pounds on April 1, 1937 compared with 2,422,696,000 pounds on April 1, 1936, and 2,209,842,000 pounds on January 1, 1937. Total stocks were 146,658,000 pounds lower than a year ago April 1 and 66,196,000 pounds higher than on January 1, 1937.

Stocks of flue-cured tobacco were reported as 872,416,000 pounds on April 1, 1937, about one hundred million pounds lower than the January 1 stocks and about a million and a half pounds lower than a year ago. The stocks of Type 11 on April 1, 1937 were reported as 387,946,000 pounds; Type 12 as 275,717,000 pounds; Type 13 as 143,256,000 pounds; Type 14 as 65,497,000 pounds.

Stocks of fire-cured tobacco of all types were reported as 215,798,000 pounds on April 1, 1937, compared with 242,178,000 pounds on April 1, 1936, a decrease of 26,380,000 pounds. Virginia Fire-cured, Type 21, stocks were reported as 30,247,000 pounds on April 1, 1937; Type 22 as 136,468,000 pounds; Type 23 as 45,783,000 pounds; and Type 24 as 3,300,000 pounds.

Burley stocks were over 96 million pounds lower on April 1, 1937 than they were a year ago April 1. The April 1, 1937 report shows 634,831,000 pounds. Maryland tobacco, Type 32, stocks were reported as 31,571,000 pounds on April 1, 1937.

One Sucker stocks on April 1, 1937 were 27,818,000 pounds; Green River stocks were 26,879,000 pounds; Virginia Sun-cured, 2,975,000 pounds; Eastern Ohio, 462,000 pounds; Perique, 160,000 pounds; Other Miscellaneous Domestic, 544,000 pounds and Foreign-grown cigarette tobacco (Turkish and other) 78,105,000 pounds.

APRIL 1 CIGAR LEAF TOBACCO STOCKS

Stocks of American-grown cigar-filler types amounted to 205,721,000 pounds on April 1, 1937, an increase of 5,812,000 pounds over the stocks of April 1, 1936. Compared with a year ago Types 41, 43 and 44 are higher; and Types 42, 45 and 46 are lower. Type 41, Pennsylvania Seedleaf, stocks were 111,014,000 pounds on April 1, 1937; Type 42, Gebhardt, 17,767,000 pounds; Type 43, Zimmer, 25,513,000 pounds; Type 44, Dutch, 12,422,000 pounds; Type 45, Georgia and Florida Sun-grown, 1,554,000 pounds; and Type 46, Puerto Rican, 37,451,000 pounds. The detailed report by groups of grades shows 149,019,000 pounds or about 72 percent of the total filler type stocks in the O group as strictly filler grades; 46,567,000 pounds, or about 23 percent in the X group as stemming grades; 6,091,000 pounds or about 3 percent in the Y group as Ground Leaves; and the balance in the R, S and N groups.

The cigar-binder type stocks, some of which are used for wrappers, were 6,364,000 pounds lower on April 1, 1937 than they were April 1 a year ago. Total binder type stocks were reported as 156,686,000 pounds on April 1, 1937. Type 51, Connecticut Broadleaf stocks were reported as 36,641,000 pounds; Type 52, Connecticut Havana Seed, 27,949,000 pounds; Type 53, New York and Pennsylvania Havana Seed, 2,458,000 pounds; Type 54, Southern Wisconsin, 56,909,000 pounds; and Type 55, Northern Wisconsin, 32,729,000 pounds. The detailed report shows that of the total binder type stocks reported 5,346,000 pounds are of wrapper quality, 67,185,000 pounds are binders, 5,266,000 pounds are fillers, 78,304,000 pounds are X group or stemming grade tobacco, and the balance in the Y, S, and N groups.

Shade-grown wrapper type stocks were reported on April 1, 1937, as 11,733,000 pounds. Connecticut Shade stocks were 8,636,000 pounds, and Georgia and Florida Shade stocks were 3,097,000 pounds. Of the total shade tobacco stocks reported 9,951,000 pounds are shown in the A group as being of actual wrapper quality.

The foreign-grown cigar-leaf tobacco stocks in the United States on April 1, 1937, consisted of 7,491,000 pounds of Cuba (Havana) tobacco, 1,993,000 pounds of Sumatra and Java, and 827,000 pounds of Philippine Island (Manila). The detailed report shows these stocks subdivided into wrappers, fillers and scrap.

The figures quoted for type totals are the sums of unstemmed and stemmed leaf as reported. For information on American-grown types shown on a farm-sales-weight basis with stemmed leaf converted to unstemmed equivalent, see page 12 of this report.
