

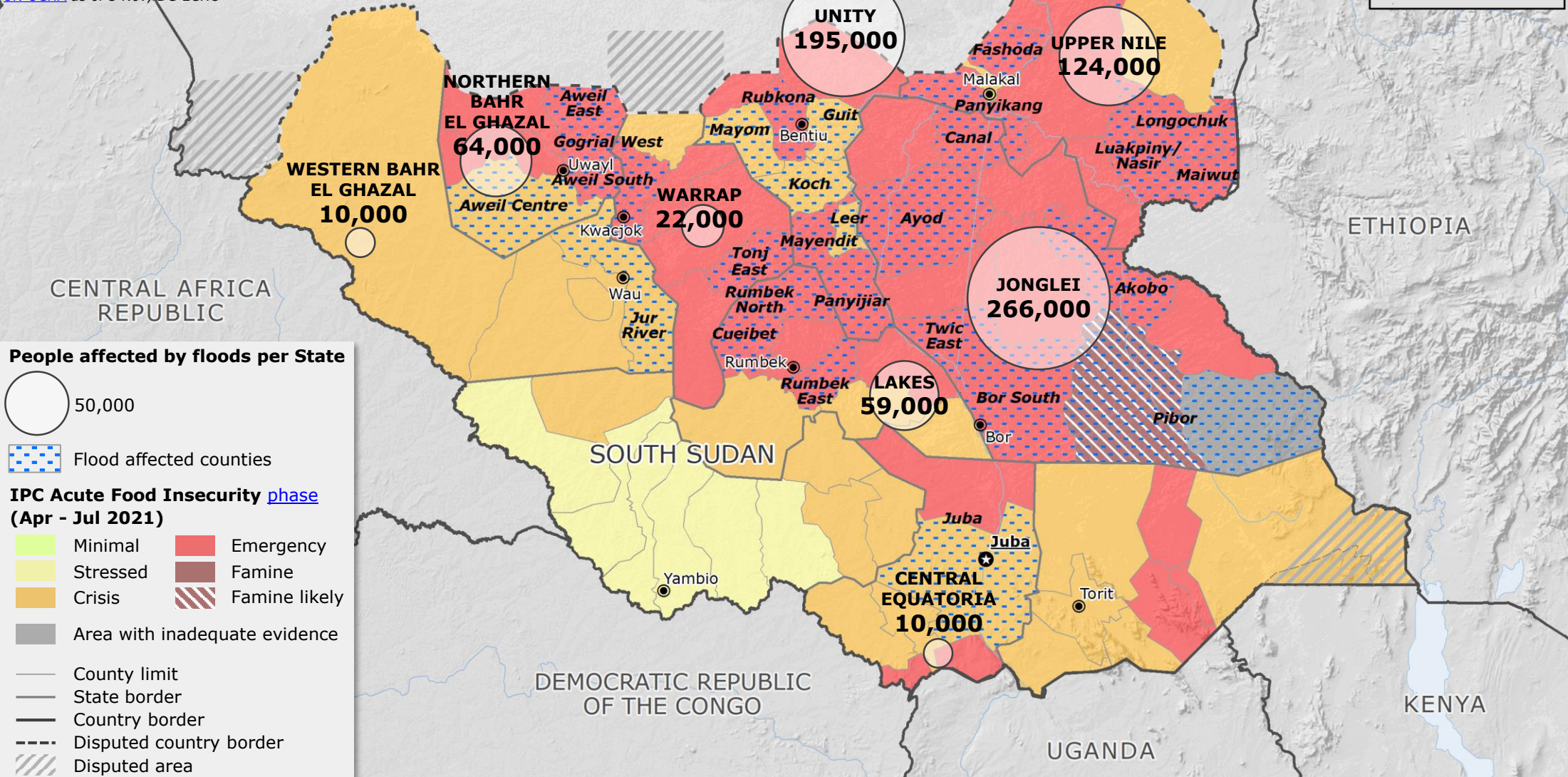
South Sudan | Floods

≈ 760,000	South Sudanese affected by floods
2.27 million	Refugees in neighbouring countries
1.71 million	Internally Displaced Persons (IDPs)
8.4 million	People in need of humanitarian assistance

In light of the unprecedented situation, the **European Commission** has allocated emergency humanitarian funding (**ALERT: Acute Large Emergency Response Tool**) of **EUR 2 million** to provide vulnerable populations with life-saving water and sanitation (WASH), shelter and other essential non-food items.
