SUBJECT : Telegraph Service for Approved Private Companies

1. It is directed that the Japanese Ministry of Communications arrange to handle private telegraph messages sent by or addressed to the Pacific Overseas Airlines as follows:

a. After censorship, messages addressed to PACAIR, Tokyo shall be delivered promptly by messenger to the Pacific Overseas Airlines at Miesner House, 5861 Kaneko Machi-oi, Shinagawa-ku, Tokyo.

b. Messages filed by the Pacific Overseas Airlines will be sent in clear English.

c. Messages may be sent from Tokyo to the Pacific Overseas Airlines, International Airport, Ontario, California.

2. This account shall be in the name of the Pacific Overseas Airlines, International Airport, Ontario, California.
