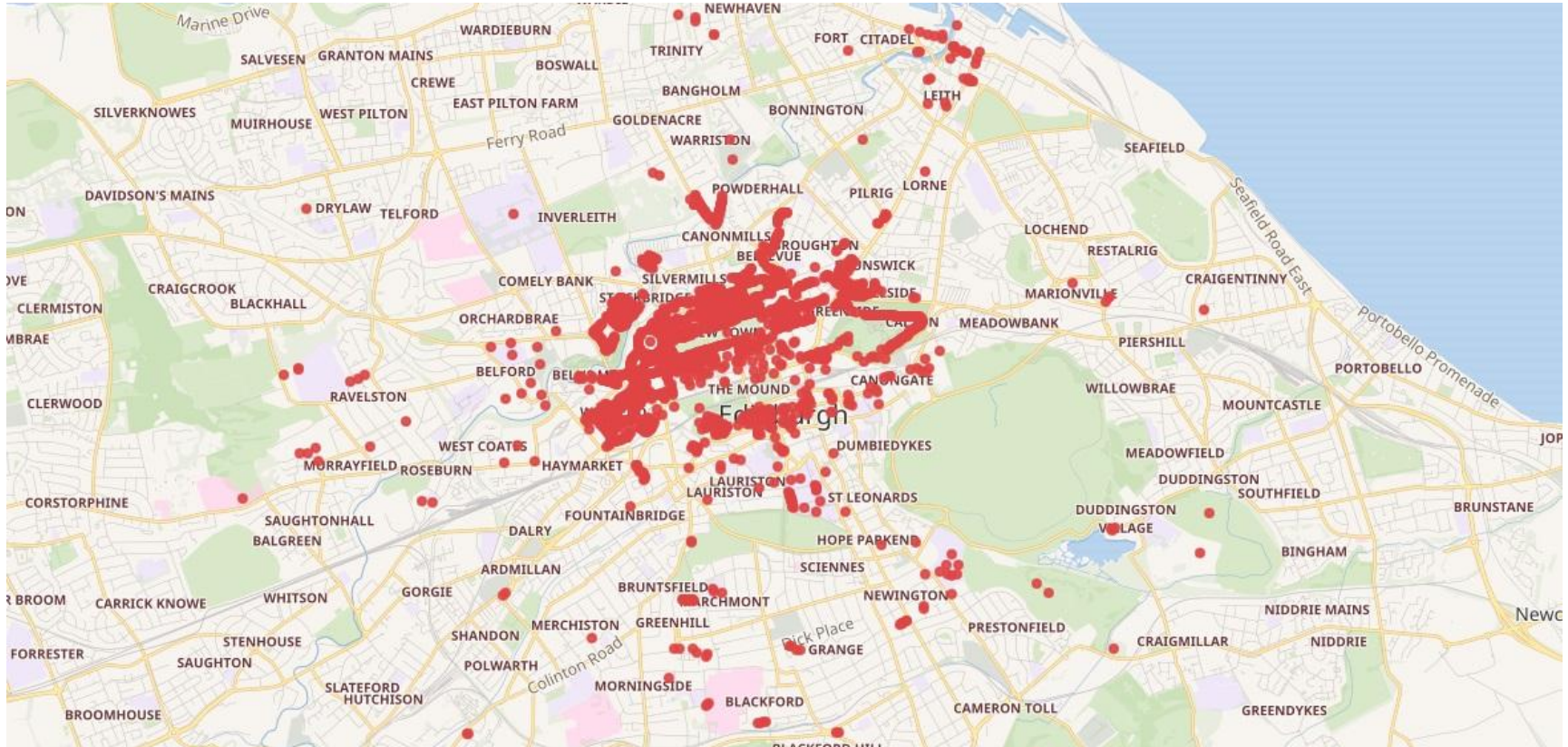




Applications in the UK

- With more than 1.5 million photographs uploaded from across the world
- The UK contest is based on heritage sites designated by England, Wales, Scotland, and Northern Ireland covering
 - Scheduled monuments (archaeological sites)
 - Listed buildings
