

Common weeks (common Ukrainian-Armenian week provided)

- During the common week in Ukrainian Wikipedia
 252 articles has been created on the Armenian thematic.
- During the common week in Armenian Wikipedia 177 articles has been created on the Ukrainian thematic.
- Common Ukrainian-Armenian week had been planned for the period of two weeks, but at the end of the second week due to a big interest from both parties it has been continued up to a one month.



- During the common week in Ukrainian Wikipedia there were 12 registered participants;
 During the common week in Armenian Wikipedia there were 14 registered participants;
- There were also a number of unregistered participants who created and improved the articles.

Ukrainian-Armenian common
weeks yearly

Articles about settlements

- Armenian user Ahaik has created (by his bot) in Armenian Wikipedia nearly one half of all amount of cities & villages in Ukraine.
- In the nearest future he is going to finish creating the articles in Armenian Wikipedia about all cities, towns and villages of Ukraine.
- There are articles in Ukrainian Wikipedia about all Armenian cities and nearly one half of villages of the Republic of Armenia and nearly 85% of villages in the Republic of Mountainous Karabakh.
- In the nearest future Ukrainian Wikipedians are going to complete creating the articles about Armenian villages.

Freedom of panorama

- Armenia & Moldova are the only two states in the territory of former U.S.S.R. which provides a freedom of panorama.
- ➤ Wikimedia Armenia was an initiator of making changes to the current legislation of the Republic of Armenia in the question of freedom of panorama.
- > Ukraine don't have a freedom of panorama at the moment.
- Wikimedia Ukraine is interested to receive successful experience of Wikimedia Armenia in the question of providing the freedom of panorama.
