is presently living with her husband. She is a German citizen.

d. Brother:

Additional information concerning the family of SUBJECT was not available.

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discharged from English Prisoner of War Camp on 6 August 1919. SUBJECT had been interned in England on 11 October 1918, Company 306, Serial Number 1h5.

4. CRIMINAL RECORD:

SUBJECT was arrested on 26 November 1945 as "Kriminal Kommissar" of the Gestapo by the MUNICH CIC Detachment 3034C. Arrest was authorized under SHAEF Automatic Arrest Directive of 13 April 1945. At the time of the arrest SUBJECT admitted having belonged to the "Allgemeine SS" since 1934. The MUNICH Spruchkammer records show that on 21 July 1949 SUBJECT was classified as a follower according to Article 17/VIII, Article 12, Section 2 of the Denazification Law. He was fined 50 DM and costs.

10. REASON FOR INVESTIGATION:

To obtain background information on persons considered for a position in the proposed Bavarian ISA. SUBJECT was reported as being a nominee for such a position.

11. RESULTS OF INVESTIGATION:

- a. SUBJECT was reported to be a very industrious and conscientious police official, who places his personal interests behind those of his profession and who strives to do more than the duties assigned to him. His character and morals are without objection. SUBJECT is a capable speaker and practices good manners. His leadership abilities are especially pronounced. In his official capacity he is very strict. His disposition at the first meeting seems moderately bad and it requires some time before one can gain his confidence. He lives a reserved private life and has hardly any friends. However, his connections in the intelligence service since 1934 have proved him a very good informant as well as theoretical person and his experiences were completely confidential.

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that he could handle the management of an intelligence service.

- b. In his political beliefs SUBJECT is opposed to Communism. He stated that he became a member of the NSDAP during the Nazi regime because he was compelled to obey the ruling regime. Consequently, he did not always agree with the Nazi measures and was not backward about giving vent to his impulsive nature when he was among his friends. BLUEHMAYER was supposedly always a rightist in the political field; he used to belong to the Bavarian People's Party and could possibly be a CSU or BP (Bavarian Party) sympathizer.

- c. In 1921 SUBJECT was employed by the MUNICH Police as a plain clothes investigator. BLUEHMAYER conducted investigations on NSDAP illegal activities from 1928 to 1933. During that period he was in the Political Department of the MUNICH Police Directorate as "Kriminalhauptwachtkorps". After the establishment of the Nazi regime he was ordered to reverse his investigations and to concentrate on the activities of the KPD. The National Socialists released him from his political assignment and transferred him to the Bavarian Political Police (BPP-Bayerische Volkspolizei) in 1935. In this capacity he did some case work against leftist movements and at times served as Head of the Intelligence Service. When the Gestapo took over he remained in the same position and in 1939 was promoted to Head of the Political Department of the MUNICH Gestapo. In 1942 he was arrested, because Heinrich WELTZ, Chief of the MUNICH (M53/Z75) office, wanted another man in charge of the MUNICH office. In the summer of 1944 SUBJECT became Head of the Political Intelligence Service in SALZBURG. He remained as such in SALZBURG until the end of the war. From 1942 until the collapse of Germany BLUEHMAYER again conducted investigations on KPD activities.

- d. SUBJECT became an automatic arrestee as "Kriminalkommissar" of the Gestapo and was interned at the VG-SIEGEN (M49/Z19) Civilian Internment Camp in 1945. Early in 1946 he and several other MUNICH Gestapo men were requested by the British authorities to appear as witnesses in a group indictment. SUBJECT was then turned over to British custody. Later he was interned at DACHAU (M49/T76) and released from there on 26 June 1948.

- e. BLUEHMAYER is very bitter to this day about the unfair dismissal from his job and subsequent internment in 1945. He expressed disgust with the internment camp and showed an overt anti-American attitude when he was questioned by American agents in 1948. One American agent who contacted SUBJECT in 1948 stated that SUBJECT himself had been heartily disliked by other former employees of the Gestapo and by former Gestapo penetration agents who worked under him. It was alleged that BLUEHMAYER did not keep his promises to his informants nor did he protect them.

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adequately. SUBJECT told the American agent at that time that he would not work for the Americans, if he could not do his work in an official capacity as he used to do under the Gestapo.

f. SUBJECT was contacted again by an American agent in November 1949. At that time too he expressed his innocence of any crime as police official in his twenty-four (24) years service and maintained that he was unjustly interned for thirty-seven (37) months. As proof of his innocence he produced a letter from the Ministry of the Interior, which stated that prospects were good for his (SUBJECT's) employment with the Border Police. He felt certain that he would be back in the police force by 1 January 1950. BLUMENFELD also stated at the time of the interview that he was unwilling to work directly for Americans, but that he would accept a position with a German office which is responsible to the American authorities.

- g. BLUMENFELD stated that through his many years of political police activity in the field of intelligence he has established connections with people of all walks of life and various political leanings; the same is true for his contacts with colleagues in his profession.
- h. The "Spruchkammer" proceedings of SUBJECT revealed that he had treated members of the KFD and former concentration camp internees well in every respect. This fact was also confirmed by the former Norwegian Police President, Mr. WILHAVEN, who was interned at LANDSHØRD (M9/F14) as a political prisoner. He declared that BLUMENFELD had always treated him decently and courteously.
