1. According to today's conference between CHOU and TING, the special service activities in Shanghai were left to TING. Understanding has been reached that the activities of FU's faction which have been supervised by CHOU's group in the past will be confined to intelligence and that the others will be stopped.

2. There are arrangements to be made in regard to preparations of residence and others if WANG Chao-ming (T.N. Courtesy name of WANG Ching-wei) is to come to Shanghai, and we would like to get information about the approximate date beforehand. At present both CHOU and MEI are of the opinion that the time is not yet ripe for WANG Chao-ming to visit Shanghai.
