1. Our records show that your failure to submit the required number of hours work in the Army extension courses of the Command and General Staff College may require that your enrollment be cancelled at the end of the next sixty days.

2. Par. 15a (4), AR 350-300 directs that enrollments in Army extension courses will be cancelled upon failure of the student to complete successfully at least 15 credit hours within six months of receipt of first lesson, or within any subsequent six months period. Students whose record indicates that their enrollment may be subject to cancellation under these provisions are to be notified sixty days in advance of the effective date for cancellation that their enrollment is subject to cancellation for failure to meet minimum requirements unless extenuating circumstances exist. Due consideration will be given to illness, absence from home, or other circumstances beyond your control.

3. The Command and General Staff College desires to retain you as a student in its extension courses. Therefore, it is requested that you complete paragraphs 1 and 2 or 3 of the inclosed post card and return it to this college at the earliest practicable date.

(3) If the national subsidy for junior high school building construction is withdrawn, what will be the approximate delay in your area for the completion of the total number of buildings needed?

(4) If the national subsidy for junior high schools is withdrawn, to what extent will the dependence on donations jeopardize the equality of educational opportunity? It may be, for instance, that if donations are increased, poor parents may feel that they are not entitled to continue their children in school even though the attendance laws may require them to attend. Or it may be that if donations must be increased schools in different sections of a city or area may have widely differing facilities and equipment.

(5) Up to the present time what has been the general public reaction to and support of the junior high school program? If the national subsidy is withdrawn, in what way will this reaction or support possibly change?

2. a. A second report concerning junior high schools, as outlined in Inclosure 1, is also desired. This report is for the public schools of the prefecture and will be prepared by the Superintendent.

b. The following explanation is given for clarification of some of the items:

(1) Section 1. Population refers to the total prefectural population. Families refers to the total number of families having children in school (any level--elementary, junior high or senior high).

(2) Section 2. Percentage refers to the percentage of reconstruction in relation to the total area before destruction.

(3) Section 3. Enrollment refers to the number of students who will enter junior high school from elementary school and senior high school from junior high school.

3. These two reports should reach this headquarters by 15 August 1949.


