2. From information contained in this report, an interesting comparison of the tactics used by labor groups in Korea and those used in Japan can be made:

a. The tactics of the leftist labor groups, who instigated the strike, appear to be similar to those used in Japan, but they appear to be of a more violent nature.

b. Whereas, in Japan the leftist labor groups have never openly admitted a tie-up with the Soviets, the leftists in Korea appear to be openly following the Moscow line and called for "full support of the Moscow decision."

c. Whereas, in Japan incidents of violence perpetrated by rightists are rare, if not non-existent, it appears from the attached report that in Korea much of the violence resulted from terroristic activities of rightists fighting against the leftists.

d. As in Japan, the leftist labor groups desired to demonstrate to the WFTU delegates the alleged "oppressions" of the labor movement in South Korea; however, in Japan no disorders or important strikes took place during the visit of the delegates and the leftist groups in Japan generally displayed discretion in their activities. On the other hand, the Korean leftists appear to have instigated an incident of violence in the presence of the delegates and carried out a series of strikes which were going on while the delegates were in Korea.

3. The Standard Operating Procedure attached to this report will go far in orienting the new personnel presently under orders to the 971st Counter Intelligence Corps Detachment and aiding them in maintaining the high efficiency shown by the present personnel of this detachment.

All Counter Intelligence Corps credentials and badges which were possessed by personnel transferred from the 441st Counter Intelligence Corps Detachment to the 319th Military Intelligence Company were turned in and disposed of in accordance with ltr AG 200.2 (10 Aug 44) OB-S-B-N, Subj: "Issuance of Credentials and Badges to CIC Personnel", dated 12 Aug 44. The changes made as a result of the above were reported in the monthly Badge and Credential Report from the 441st Counter Intelligence Corps Detachment, for the month of January and February, dated 15 Jan 47 and 15 Feb 47.

2. Reference paragraph 4, basic communication, it is planned to transfer the remaining linguist personnel presently assigned to the 441st Counter Intelligence Corps Detachment to the 319th Military Intelligence Company, not later than 30 April 1947 in view of the fact that the T/O for Counter Intelligence Corps provides no vacancies for linguists (SSN - 9330, 9332, 267, and 320). Under local conditions no investigative agency like CIC can function without linguists. In telecon 12 September 1946 we proposed linguists within CIC T/O & E as the proper solution which was not concurred in. The 319th Military Intelligence Company is attached to the 441st Counter Intelligence Corps Detachment and the transfer of such linguist personnel is merely an administrative regrouping to insure that linguists occupy appropriate vacancies.
