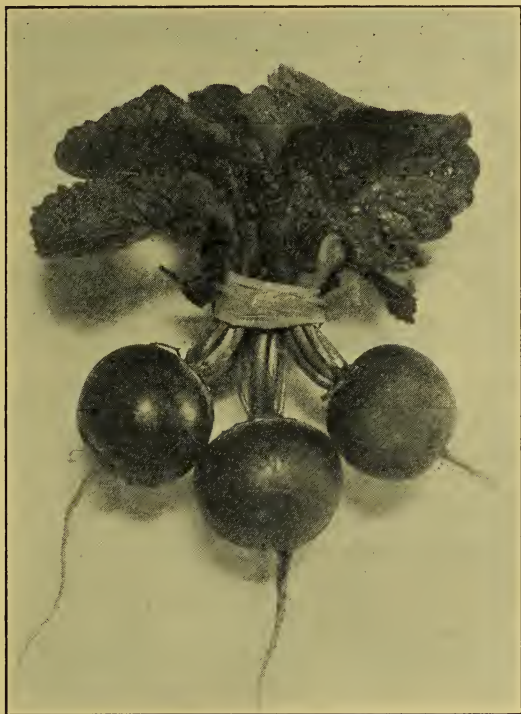

If goods are wanted by parcel post, an amount sufficient to cover postage charges must be added to the order. A complete table of Parcel-Post Rates is given below. Fluids and poisons are not mailable.

Our terms are Cash with Order, except to customers who are personally known to us or have an approved credit rating.

C. O. D. shipments may be made by express (not by freight) if an amount sufficient to cover express charges and guarantee acceptance upon arrival accompanies the order. Small shipments may be made by parcel post, C. O. D. Under no circumstances will we ship perishable goods, such as bulbs, onion sets, etc., C. O. D.

Please help us to fill and ship your orders accurately and with all possible dispatch, by noting carefully the following instructions:

Send us your order as early as possible. Use the enclosed order sheet. Always keep a copy. Write your name and address distinctly on every order you send us. Give your Name, Post Office, County and State, also Box, Route or Street Number. Give complete shipping instructions on every order. Send your remittance by Post Office or Express Money Order, Registered Letter or Draft. For small amounts stamps are acceptable.

Correspondence should not be intermingled with the body of the order, but should be written on a separate sheet.

With regard to errors, we take every possible precaution to avoid their occurrence. Notify us at once if your order is not properly filled and we will make the necessary adjustment.

Parcel Post Rates

Parcels of seeds and bulbs, weighing less than 8 ounces must pay postage to all zones at the rate of 1 cent for each 2 ounces; in excess of 8 ounces at pound rates.

Parcels of general merchandise weighing 4 ounces or less must pay postage to all zones at the rate of 1 cent per ounce; in excess of 4 ounces at pound rates.
