

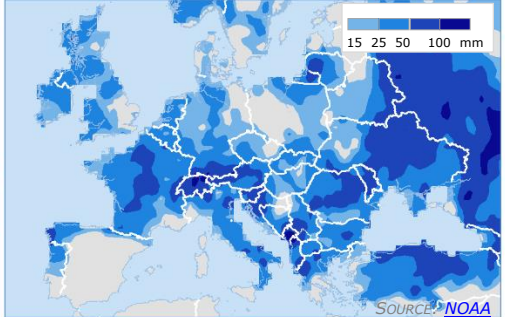
SITUATION

- Severe weather conditions (rain, winds, thunderstorms and storm surge) are affecting northern Europe. As of 30 May, several Meteo Alarm - Orange Alerts are still in effect in Europe (see map).
 - In France, heavy rain and thunderstorms, affected several parts of the country, especially the city of Paris, causing the injury of 11 people.
 - In Germany, severe weather affected several parts of the country, especially the state Rhineland-Palatinate, causing the death of three people and injuring at least 30.
 - Severe weather also affected Poland, resulting in the death of one person in the Babia Gora mountain area.

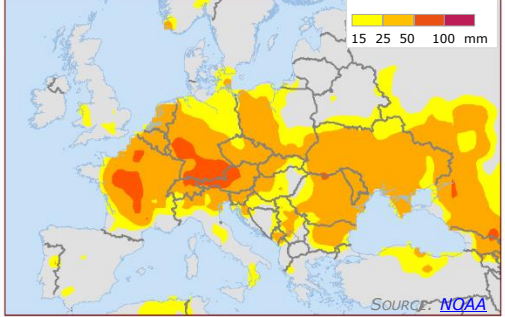
Reported high discharges/floods warnings during the last 24 hours by National services (EFAS)

- Belgium:** The hydrological information centre for Flanders reports alarm levels for several small water sheds in the south east of the country.
- Germany:** National services report exceedance of 3rd and 2nd alert levels for rivers Riss, Frankische Rezat and Ohrn.
- Germany:** National services report exceedance of 3rd and 2nd alert levels for rivers Main and Neckar.
