2. For your information, we have furnished the Bundesamt fuer Verfassungsschutz with the following trace on SUBJECT:

A trace is held on one P. J. KOOYMANS, born circa 1904, a Dutch national, reported in approximately 1944 to have resided at GROESBEEKSCHEURG, Holland. SUBJECT was SS member, his career as follows: Standartenfuehrer, Netherland SS head of SS Standarte, organized Netherlands SS in BRABANT and LUMBURG, Police President in ENDHOVEN by April 1943, Assistant Director General of Police in NIJMEGEN in 1943, Director General of Dutch Police in 1943, served in Russia in 1942 and 1944. 1. In October 1955, CAVATA requested traces on the following applicant for CAVATA employment:

It is possible that since initiation of the above request CAVATA has already employed KOOYMANS.

2. A Dutch interrogation report on Gerard J. WERDLER (WNH 1498, 22 May 1950) contains the following information concerning Subject:

(Page 5, paragraph w.):
"At one of the hearings, WERDLER told that in Leipzig he often used to meet a KOOYMANS, the man who in the war was for a time Head of the Directorate General of Police in Nimeguen (sic), and later fought as an S.S.-officer at the East Front against the Russians. Said KOOYMANS is said to hold a prominent post in the Russian Intelligence Service in Leipzig."

Dutch commented on the above report that they did not take WERDLER's statements too seriously, although certain parts had been found to be true.

3. It is requested that the Station request clearance from for KUBARK to pass the above information to CAVATA and request any additional information Dutch may have regarding Subject's alleged connections.

1. First reference requested [Dutch] clearance for KUBARK to pass to CAVATA certain derogatory information concerning Subject, and to obtain any additional information [Dutch] might have on KOOYMANS. Second reference was an inquiry regarding the status of the negotiations with [Dutch].

2. In view of the fact that Subject was an applicant for CAVATA employment in October 1955 and in the meantime may have been hired by CAVATA, we are most anxious to clarify the information contained in paragraph two of first reference. We should appreciate it, therefore, if you could ask [Dutch] to handle our request as soon as possible. It is suggested that [KUBARK] notify Bonn directly of the results of their negotiations with [Dutch] sending information copies to Frankfurt and Headquarters.

SUBJECT: P.J. KOOYMANS.

(With reference to your a.m. letter we herewith pass you the following information on subject. Petrus Johannes KOOYMANS, born 1-10-'06 Drummel, was inspector of police at Venlo up to 1941, after which date he organized the Dutch S.S. in the provinces of Limburg and Brabant. He held the rank of "Hauptsturmführer Waffen S.S.". After serving for a few months in 1942 at the East front, subject was appointed Police-president at Eindhoven. On 1-9-'43 he was made Head of the General Staff of the Directorate-General of Police at Nimeguen. In January 1944 he was again sent to the East front, and was made prisoner-of-war by the Russians on an unknown date.

(According to information received from a Dutch subject released from Russian captivity KOOYMANS was detained in the "Peter and Paul Fortress" in Leningrad from '45 to '47. Thereafter he was detained in one or more camps until in 1950 he was sentenced to 25 years' imprisonment in Kiev.

After his release KOOYMANS arrived on 20-10-'53 at the Friedland Camp in Western Germany; he did not want to repatriate to the Netherlands, but preferred to stay in Western Germany. Many of subject's former camp-mates thought, that KOOYMANS behaved very well in captivity.

After the war a rumour was afloat in quarters of interned political offenders, that KOOYMANS was in the Eastern zone of Germany, and had entered Russian employment as broadcaster with the Russian radio. (G) WERDLER's information reported by our CAE/56/269 of 11-5-'50, that he had several times met subject, who was working for the Russian Intelligence Service, at Leipzig, may presumably refer to this rumour, as informant, who has meanwhile been found unreliable, also stayed for some time in detention-camps after the war.)

As the said rumour and (WERDLER's information have in no way been credibly confirmed, and they are moreover contradicted by the antecedents given above about KOOYMANS, we do not attach any value to the rumour in question.

(We do not object to your passing the above data to the Germans.

1. We regret the delay in replying to your request for further information on **ROTHMANN**, but the [Dutch] report has only now reached Headquarters. [Dutch] reports the following additional information:

a. According to information received from a Dutch subject released from Russian captivity, **ROTHMANN** was detained in the 'Peter and Paul Fortress' in Leningrad from 1945 to 1947. Thereafter, he was detained in one or more camps until in 1950 he was sentenced to 25 years' imprisonment in Kiev.

b. After his release **ROTHMANN** arrived on 20-10-53 at the Friedland Camp in Western Germany; he did not seek to repatriate to the Netherlands, but preferred to stay in Western Germany. Many of subject's former camp-mates thought that **ROTHMANN** behaved very well in captivity.

c. After the war a rumor was afloat in quarters of interned political offenders that **ROTHMANN** was in the Eastern zone of Germany, and had entered Russian employment as broadcaster with the Russian radio. **G. WHEELER**'s information (see paragraph 4b of second reference) that he had several times met subject, who was working for the Russian Intelligence Service at Leipzig, may presumably refer to this rumor, as informant—who has meanwhile been found unreliable—also stayed for some time in detention camps after the war.

d. As the said rumor and **WHEELER**'s information have in no way been credibly confirmed, and they are moreover contradicted by the statements given above about **ROTHMANN**, we do not attach any value to the rumor in question.

1. We have developed the following information on Subject:

a. According to information received from a Dutch subject released from Russian captivity, KOOYMANS was detained in the "Peter and Paul Fortress" in Leningrad from 1945 to 1947. Thereafter, he was detained in one or more camps until 1950 when he was sentenced to 25 years imprisonment in Kiev.

b. After his release, KOOYMANS arrived on 20.10.53 at the Friedland Camp in West Germany; he did not wish to be repatriated to the Netherlands, but preferred to stay in West Germany. Many of Subject's former fellow inmates thought that KOOYMANS behaved very well in captivity.

c. After the war, a rumor arose among interned political offenders that KOOYMANS was in the Soviet Zone of Germany and had entered Russian employment as a broadcaster with the Russian radio. One source, who later proved to be unreliable, claimed to have met KOOYMANS several times in Leipzig and alleged that KOOYMANS held a prominent post with the RIS in that city. Neither the rumor of KOOYMANS' Russian radio employment nor his alleged RIS activity are granted any credence and are moreover contradicted by other information.

2. We ask that you provide this office with any reaction from the BfV on the above information.

1. Reference is made to your memorandum of 23 October 1956, Subject as above.

2. Under date of 28 November 1956 the BfV has advised as follows concerning the information provided them re KOOYMANS;

"In answer to paragraph 2 of your correspondence (in which this office requested BfV opinion with regard to the information provided them), you are advised that similar information was reported from this side concerning an (fnu) KOOYMANS. Investigations initiated here have revealed no identity between your trace and the SUBJECT of our request, and have in fact indicated SUBJECT to be a convinced anti-communist ("kompromisslosen Anti-kommunisten"). Finally, it is pointed out that the name KOOYMANS is very common in Holland."

1. The information on KOOYMANS which was transmitted to this office under both references was passed to CAVATA via ODOPAL without, of course, revealing the origin of the information.

2. Upon receiving this information, CAVATA commented that they had received similar information on a (fnu) KOOYMANS through their own resources. However, their subsequent investigations have revealed that the KOOYMANS on whom we provided information is not identical with the KOOYMANS on whom they originally requested traces (sic)*. These investigations have shown KOOYMANS to be a convinced anti-Communist. They also pointed out that KOOYMANS is a fairly common name in Holland.

3. We assume that CAVATA is employing KOOYMANS in a covert capacity.

*(Field Comment: We believe what they really mean here is that the two persons are identical, but that the derogatory information does not apply to KOOYMANS.)
