I return herewith your first entry report No.7928 on the new steamer "HIGHLANDER", together with the approved plans of midship section, profile and deck plating (2) of the vessel, and I shall be glad if you will state:-

- (1) Whether you are correct in stating the breadth of "C" strake as being 81".
- (2) Whether the sheerstrake has been doubled in way of well, as shown on the approved plan.
- (3) The particulars of the riveting of the butts and edges of the bridge side plating.
- (4) Whether the floors in way of the cellular double bottom are .42" thick as stated or .34" as required.

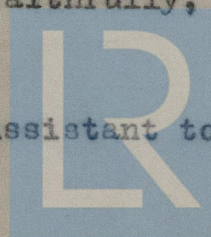
I shall be glad if you will amend the approved plans to agree with the ship as built as regards the thickness of the upper deck plating, size of bridge beams, etc.
