## INTERVIEW

1. Time & date: 1400 - 1410 hrs, 12 Jan 1950
2. Visitor: Mr. S. Akiyama, Councillor of J.R.C. Kagawa Chapter.  
(Full-time paid official)
3. Subject: The funds collection campaign of J.R.C. for 1950-1 fiscal year.

## I. Mr. Akiyama's story:

A two-day conference of J.R.C. Councillors in Chugoku and Shikoku region was held in Kochi City on 10th and 11th Jan.

The main agenda of the conference was to study the measure and establishing the prefectural goals of the funds collection campaign of J.R.C. for 1950-1 fiscal year which will be carried out in May 1950 by J.R.C. alone according to the agreement settled between Community Chest and J.R.C. last year. This means two funds collection campaign will be carried out within 1950 that is, one for J.R.C. in May and another for Community Chest in Oct.

The staff of J.R.C. are of the opinion that the campaign will be successfully carried out as they have enough personnel for collection. They presume that it will be easier for the people who make contribution, that making a little amount of contribution once in May and five months later another one ~~little~~ than making a lump sum of contribution once in Oct.

## II. Conversation summary exchanged between Mr. Carr &amp; Mr. Akiyama:

Though Mr. Carr was invited to attend the primary meeting of the Kagawa Chapter's Funds Collection Committee which was going to be held at Jichi Kaikan (Self-government Meeting Hall) Goban-cho, Takamatsu-shi on 14th Jan at 11 a.m. he said that he would not be able to attend it as the basic policy of Civil Affairs Region was not allowing the participation of its personnel directly in Japanese program like this.

Lastly, Mr. Akiyama on behalf of J.R.C. Shikoku region expressed his desire that pertinent advice and guidance in relate to the J.R.C. activities would be given by Mr. Carr this year. Mr Carr told that he would try to help them but as Miss Randolph was in charge of Community Chest and J.R.C. affairs she would be much interested in this matter.

Sanuki Gakuen (home for dependent, neglected and abused children), (Private).

Director: Mr. Saeki (Priest) *Buddhist*

1. History: Established by a priest (Shingon Sect) in 1899 by the request of Chief Warden of the Takamatsu *gail* to accommodate the children whose parents were in *gail* and being looked after by no one. Then the nature of the institution gradually developed into an orphanage, and in 1932 it was reorganized as the Priests' Association of the same sect in this prefecture will be responsible for the management of the institution.

2. Number of inmates: 44 boys and 39 girls

3. Age range of the inmates: 1 to 18 years old.

4. Principal factors of children being accommodated:

Orphans:	29
Neglected:	32
<u>Poverty:</u>	24
Abandoned:	6
