Temperature and the daily snow depth
for the HANAOKA POW CAMP

10 July 1947

The nearest METRO STATION to the HANAOKA POW CAMP is situated in Odate (approx. position, Lat. 40°-15' N., Long. 140°-35' E. in AKITA KEN (Prefecture) and is at 61 meters above sea level.

I. Temperature.(F)

The daily high and low temperature has not been reported to the Central Meteorological Observatory and now being asked to the Odate METRO Station. The reply is expected in hand in 10 days if they have the record thereof. The statistical data available at the C.M.O. are as follows:

As can be seen in th table,daily records in March 1945 are not available at the Central Meteorological Observatory, so the data are now being asked to the Odate METRO Station and can be furnish later, but the general report of snow in March 1945 is as follows

Max. snow depth -- 112 c.m. (1 March)

Days above 20 c.m. - 31

" " 100 " 7

" " 200 " nil

End of snow fall in this year -- 15 April.

III. Relative position of the HANAOKA POW CAMP.

- 1) Direct distance between Hanaoka Camp and Odate METRO Station:
6.7 Kilometers.
- 2) Elevation between Hanaoka and Odate:
Hanaoka Camp is estimated to be higher than Odate by 15 or 16
meters.
