REGULATIONS, DATED 10TH JANUARY, 1950, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS UNDER SUB-SECTION (2) OF SECTION FOUR OF THE FIRE SERVICES ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) (REPRINT), 1947.

1950. No. 5

The Ministry of Home Affairs, by virtue and in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sub-section (2) of Section Four of the Fire Services Act (Northern Ireland) (Reprint), 1947, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations.

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Fire Services (Standard Fire Provision) (Western Fire Authority) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1950.

(2) In these Regulations the expression "the principal Regulations" means the Fire Services (Standard Fire Provision) (Western Fire Authority) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1947.

(3) These Regulations shall be construed as one with the principal Regulations and shall have effect as from the date hereof.

2. The following sub-paragraph shall be substituted for sub-paragraph (1) (a) of paragraph 1 of the Schedule to the principal Regulations :—

“(1) (a) a whole-time chief officer and five whole-time fire officers, of whom there shall be at least one continuously on duty in Londonderry ;”

3. The following table shall be substituted for the table in sub-paragraph (2) of paragraph 1 of the Schedule to the principal Regulations :—

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Fire Services (Standard Fire Provision) (Southern Fire Authority) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1950.

(3) These Regulations shall be construed as one with the principal Regulations and shall have effect as from the date hereof.
