
- 1. Turn out in east pasture in spring.
- 2. Open gate to south pasture June 30.
- August 1. Open gate to west pasture and try to concentrate livestock for seed trampling.
- 4. North pasture is rested season long.



- 1. Turn out in south pasture in spring.
- 2. Open gate to north pasture June 30.
- August 1. Open gate to east pasture and try to concentrate livestock for seed trampling.
- 4. West pasture is rested year long.



- 1. Turn out in north pasture in spring.
- Open gate to west pasture June 30.
- 3. August 1. Open gate to south pasture and try to concentrate livestock for seed trampling.
- 4. East pasture is rested year long.



- 1. Turn out in west pasture in spring.
- 2. Open gate to east pasture June 30.
- 3. August 1. Open gate to north pasture and try to concentrate livestock for seed trampling.
- 4. South pasture is rested year long.
