

PART II Narrative Summary

10ct - 130ct67: During this period only limited test flights were flown due to the CH-46A being placed on a hold status except for emergency Sparrow Hawk missions.

140ct 67: At 1205H, four Bonnie Sue aircraft were launched on a Sparrow Hawk insertion of BEECHNUT INDIA and BEECHNUT MIKE in support of a Recon team WARCLOUD which was surrounded at ZC176987. EP156 received 12 hits and the two crew members, Corporal B. M. O'DONNELL, crew chief and Corporal D. D. DELUDE, gunner were wounded.

150ct -160ct67: No Operations, all aircraft down until further notice.

170ct 67: At 1200H, HMM-265 launched five CH-46A's on a BALD EAGLE troop lift from MMAF to AT872865. Small arms fire was received with no hits or injuries sustained. At 1350H two more CH-46A's were launched on an emergency medevac from a besieged recon team TEXAS PETE at AT872880. Small arms fire was received with no hits or injuries sustained. HMM-265 again launched three CH-46A's at 1735H on a BALD EAGLE medevac mission to 20178978, which was aborted due to heavy small arms fire in the zone. EP158 sustained Charlie damage with the crew chief, Corporal H. E. MORSE, critically wounded.

180ct 67: HMM-265 launched three CH-46A's at C71CH in an attempt to hoist recon team PETRIFY out of a zone at ZC168C12. EP162, the lead aircraft received 12 hits and made a precautionary landing at ZC168C12. At O93CH two CH-46A's were launched to take maintenance personnel and 335 lbs of cargo to the downed CH-46A. The aircraft then flew SAR for Deadlock 4-2 at ZC178978.

190ct 67: At 073CH one CH 46A was launched to assist in an aircraft recovery at ZC168010, then proceeded to pick-up hime medevacs from DEFEND 14 G-3 at ZC167991.

200ct - 310ct67: Normal test flights with no specific operations.
