Naturally, as we had to take over the collection on the 1st July it was impossible for us to do anything else but find another partner which we are glad to state we have been successful in doing. Under the circumstances, of course, we regret that we cannot make you a party to the transaction.

With regard to the agreement which you seem to have been expecting, we must state that one was drafted in Geneva and would have been forwarded to you as soon as the purchase price had been paid in. As things are at present, we fear that the only concession we should be able to allow you is a reduction from 10% to 5% of the sale tax on all goods purchased by you if you came over to the sale.

Your letter of the 6th inst. is just to hand. We very much regret that you do not think our cable has done you justice.

We notice you say that if you had put up any competition against us we should not have got the collection under 30,000 dollars more than it has cost. You are quite mistaken as to this, because if the collection was to have cost us 30,000 dollars more we certainly should not have bought it, nor, pardon us, do we think you would have either. You have got into your unfortunate position entirely through your friend failing to make good at the last moment, and as we only knew about two days before the sale had to be completed that you were not going to put up a third share of the purchases, it put us into an extremely awkward corner. Naturally no firm can put its hand on so large a sum as £12,000 in a couple of days, especially in these bad times, so that we had no alternative but to find another friend who would find the money required. Naturally, therefore, the person who has found this remaining third, has one-third of the business, hether good or bad, so that it is impossible now to put you in, because the only condition of finding the money was to give that person the position that you would have had. All this seems to us perfectly straightforward, and the

We can assure you it has given us a great deal of anxiety, and the more so because it was so unexpected and sudden, and we naturally blamed you because you were so certain, and also your friend, that the money would be found without any difficulty.


As regards your complaint about our failure to supply you with an agreement, we quite understand your bankers would do nothing without some tangible proof that you had a hand in the deal, but it was impossible for us to send you any agreement other than we promised to do, namely an agreement as to the procedure to be adopted and the way the sale was to be conducted.
