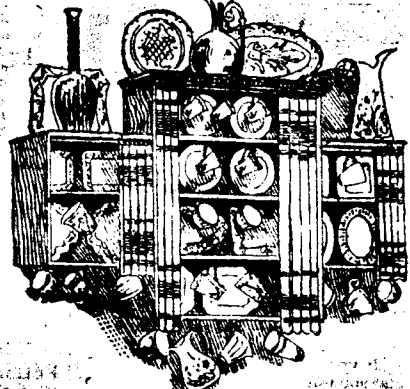

Asparagus With Eggs. Asparagus with eggs is an attractive combination devised by some culinary genius of name unknown. Boil a bunch of asparagus 20 minutes. Cut off the tender tops and lay in a deep plate, buttering, salting and peppering well.

Strawberry Float. Put four even tablespoonful of corn starch, moistened into a saucpan, add one pint of boiling water. Stir over the fire for just a minute. Take from the fire and stir in one pint of cold stand away to cool.

Expanding Closet Shelves. An expert in domestic science says: "If you paper your closet shelves, put on three thicknesses at once. It is as easy to cut three layers as one. They can be removed, then, one at a time, as they become soiled, a few dishes being removed and replaced as the paper is rolled away, and it requires much less time than to remove all the dishes and put on a new paper."

Etiquette For Brides. Prospective brides will be interested in the following from 'The Home Journal': It would be perfectly proper if you are to be married in church and in your traveling dress for you to go directly from the church to the station, omitting everything in the way of a reception or a collation.

At a quiet, home wedding the collation might consist of salads, sandwiches, loaves, meat and sweet jellies, bride's cake, small cakes, coffee, lemonade and any other beverage you may desire. Have the collation spread on one large table and let the service be informal.

At a daytime wedding, even if the bride wear all afternoon costume— that is, trousers showing a fancy pattern, black waistcoat and frock coat, white silk four-in-hand tie and white kid gloves. The bridegroom should give the bride a list of these friends, ladies and gentlemen, whose acquaintance he wishes her to make, and cards should be sent to them.

A bridal party in marching into a church where there is only one aisle would go in this order: First, the bridesmaids, two by two; then the maid of honor, walking alone, and then the bride, on the arm of her nearest male relative. The bridegroom and best man should be waiting at the altar. Returning, after the ceremony, the procession is in this order: First, the bride and bridegroom; next, the maid of honor or with the best man, then each bridesmaid on the arm of an usher.
