STOCKS OF LEAF TOBACCO OWNED BY DEALERS AND MANUFACTURERS

OCTOBER 1, 1935

Stocks of leaf tobacco in the United States owned by dealers and manufacturers amounted to 2,198,661,000 pounds on October 1, 1935, compared with 2,202,267,000 pounds on October 1, 1934, a decrease of 3,606,000 pounds. From July 1, 1935, to October 1, 1935, total stocks increased 35,924,000 pounds. During the same period of 1934 total stocks decreased 11,730,000 pounds.

Stocks of flue-cured tobacco on hand October 1, 1935, were 798,243,000 pounds, compared with 759,422,000 pounds on October 1, 1934, an increase of 38,821,000 pounds over the holdings of a year ago. During the period from July 1 to October 1, 1935, flue-cured stocks increased 156,403,000 pounds, compared with an increase of 107,358,000 pounds during the same period of 1934. Type 11 stocks were reported as 275,970,000 pounds on October 1, 1935; Type 12 as 282,600,000 pounds; Type 13 as 177,733,000 pounds; and Type 14 as 61,940,000 pounds.

Stocks of fire-cured tobacco were reported as 211,164,000 pounds on October 1, 1935, compared with 187,858,000 pounds on October 1, 1934. Total fire-cured stocks were 23,306,000 pounds higher than they were a year ago, and about 20 million pounds lower than they were on July 1, 1935. Virginia Fire-cured, Type 21, stocks were reported as 25,961,000 pounds on October 1, 1935, about 4 million pounds under the July 1 stocks. Type 22 stocks, reported as 142,748,000 pounds, were about 13 million pounds lower than the July 1 stocks. Type 23 stocks on October 1 were reported as 38,938,000 pounds, and Type 24 as 3,517,000 pounds, both slightly lower than on July 1 of this year. Types 21 and 24 were lower than they were a year ago and Types 22 and 23 were considerably higher.

Burley stocks were about 40 million pounds lower on October 1, 1935, than they were on October 1, 1934. The October 1, 1935, report shows 660,405,000 pounds. The decrease during the quarter from July 1 to October 1 was about 3 million pounds larger than the decrease during the same period of 1934. Maryland tobacco, Type 32, stocks were reported as 39,328,000 pounds on October 1, about 4 million pounds higher than a year ago and about 10 million pounds higher than on July 1.

One Sucker stocks on October 1, 1935, amounted to 29,999,000 pounds, about 2 million pounds lower than a year ago. The decrease during the quarter was slightly greater than during the same quarter of 1934. Green River stocks, reported as 30,269,000 pounds, were a little over a million pounds lower than a year ago. Virginia Sun-cured stocks were reported as 2,075,000 pounds. Miscellaneous Domestic stocks are segregated in this report into Eastern Ohio, Perique, Philippine Islands (Manila), and Other. The October 1 report shows Eastern Ohio as 1,001,000 pounds; Perique, 327,000 pounds; Philippine Islands, 1,325,000 pounds, and Other Miscellaneous Domestic, 236,000 pounds. Foreign-grown cigarette tobacco (Turkish and other) is reported as 66,440,000 pounds on October 1, 1935.

OCTOBER 1 CIGAR LEAF TOBACCO STOCKS

Stocks of American-grown cigar filler types amounted to 167,575,000 pounds on October 1, 1935, or about 288,000 pounds more than on October 1, 1934. Type 41, Pennsylvania Seedleaf stocks on October 1, 1935, were 88,544,000 pounds; Type 42, Gebhardt, 23,379,000 pounds; Type 43, Zimmer, 27,393,000 pounds; Type 44, Dutch, 6,767,000 pounds; Type 45, Georgia and Florida Sun-grown, 2,049,000 pounds; Type 46, Puerto Rican, 19,443,000 pounds. The detailed report by groups of grades shows about 75 per cent of the total filler type stocks in the C group as strictly filler grades and about 23 per cent in the X group as stemming grades.

The cigar binder type stocks, some of which are used for wrappers, were about 24 million pounds lower on October 1, 1935, than they were a year ago October 1. Total binder type stocks were reported as 168,041,000 pounds on October 1, 1935. Type 51, Connecticut Broadleaf stocks were reported as 32,188,000 pounds; Type 52, Connecticut Havana Seed, 28,013,000 pounds; Type 53, New York and Pennsylvania Havana Seed, 1,751,000 pounds; Type 54, Southern Wisconsin, 68,486,000 pounds; Type 55, Northern Wisconsin, 37,603,000 pounds. The detailed report by groups of grades shows that of the total binder type stocks reported, 3,945,000 pounds are of wrapper quality, 63,634,000 pounds are binders, 9,009,000 pounds are fillers, 91,228,000 pounds are X group or stemming grade tobacco, and the balance scrap and nondescript.

Shade-grown wrapper type stocks were 1,222,000 pounds lower on October 1, 1935, than on October 1, 1934. The October 1 report of this year shows a total of 11,636,000 pounds of shade wrapper type stocks on hand. Connecticut Valley Shade stocks were reported as 7,547,000 pounds, and Georgia and Florida Shade stocks as 4,089,000 pounds. Of the total shade tobacco stocks reported, 9,319,000 pounds are shown in the A group as being of actual wrapper quality.

Foreign-grown cigar-leaf tobacco was segregated in the October 1, 1935, report on the basis of country of origin, and on the basis of wrappers, fillers and scrap. Stocks in the United States of Cuban (Havana) tobacco totaled 8,938,000 pounds, and stocks of Sumatra, Java, and other foreign-grown cigar-leaf totaled 1,659,000 pounds on October 1, 1935.
