## A brief history of Wikipedia for Schools

SOS Children began work on Wikipedia for Schools in 2005. We wanted to make articles from Wikipedia available freely for use in schools and educational projects across the developing world, where internet access is often non-existent.

In April 2006, the first edition was released onto CD as "A World of Learning, and shipped to schools in developing countries by SOS Children and others. SOS Children bore most of the production and distribution costs, although some of the distribution was funded by other charities such as the Shuttleworth Foundation in South Africa. At the time, Wikipedia was not available in offline, making Wikipedia for Schools uniquely positioned to provide a vital learning resource to children across the developing world.

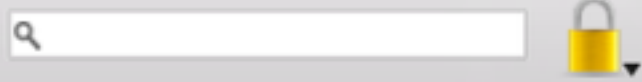
In November 2006, the Wikimedia Foundation endorsed the project, and a year after the project's first release, it was relaunched as "Wikipedia for Schools" and moved to [www.schools-wikipedia.org](http://www.schools-wikipedia.org). Ever since, we have continued to enjoy the support of WMF.

In 2006, "A World of Learning" fitted onto CD-ROM, with 2006 pages of text and

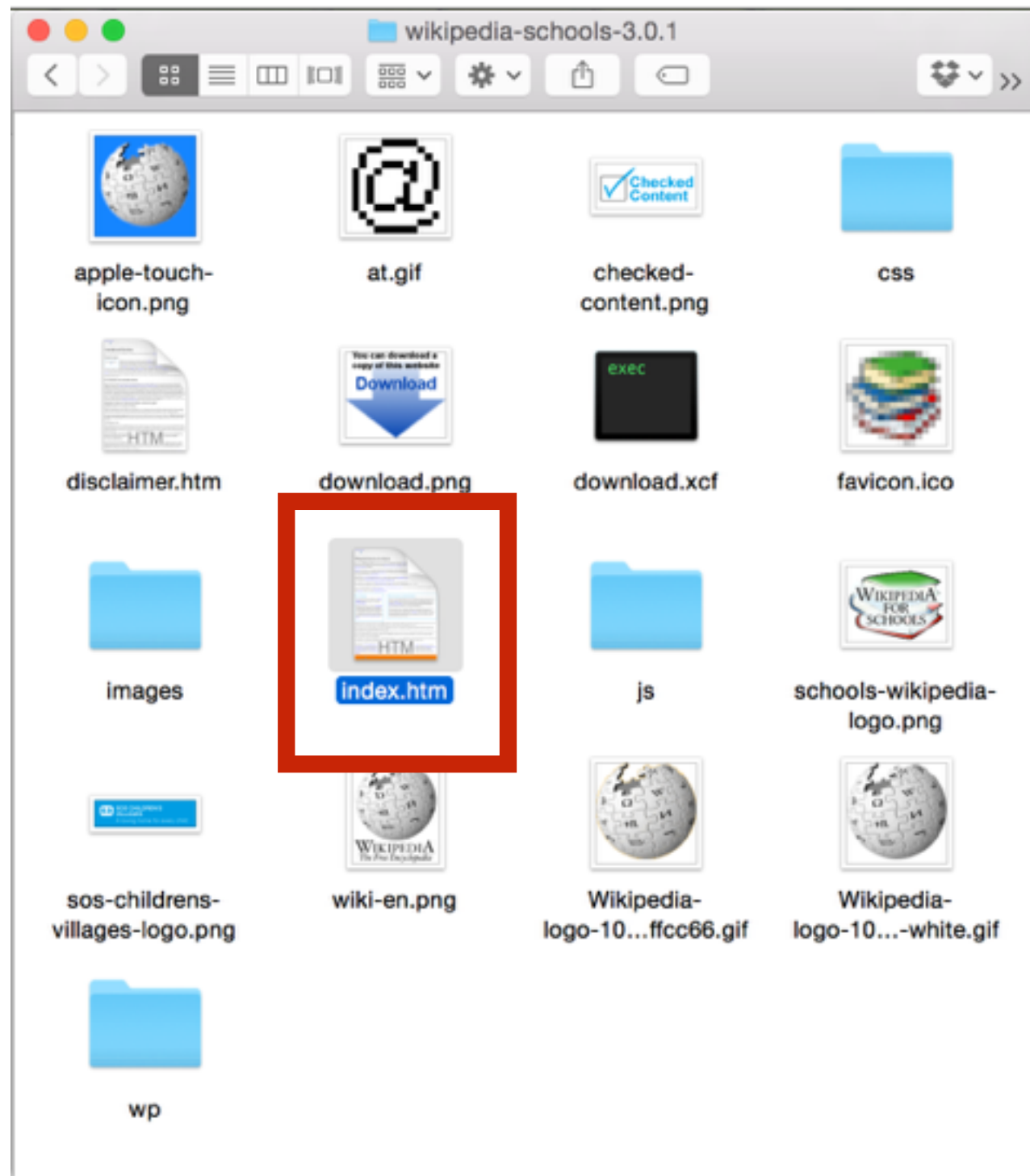

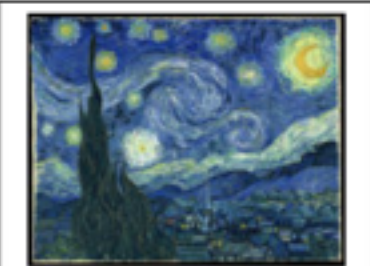

The contents of this Schools Wikipedia has been organised by subject along the lines of subjects in the UK curriculum. There are 5500 articles, some of which have been listed under several subjects. The general principle has been that this subject index should be helpful rather than categorising. So for example we have still listed Pluto in the category of planets even though it is not considered a planet any more and Russia as a country has been included in both Europe and Asia. We have often listed people both in the biographies (of which there are 850) but also under the area of study for which they were famous. If you struggle to find a particular article we suggest you try the title index which includes every word of the title of every article (including alternative titles, so Pyrites are listed under Pyrites, Fool and Gold). Most topics related to the natural world, including a lot of information on birds, plants, dinosaurs, medicine, insects and so on are under Science / Biology. This classification was done by hand so please report errors. In our first version in 2005 we found a helpful volunteer had

classified Brussels as a vegetable!

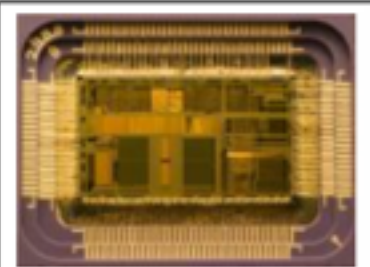

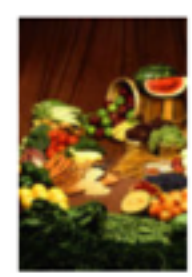

The index includes words from all article titles included in the selection and words from any redirects which point to those articles. If an article is listed against a word which is not in it's title, then there is a redirect on the English Wikipedia with the word in which points to the article. You can hover your mouse over the article title to see the redirect that caused that index entry.

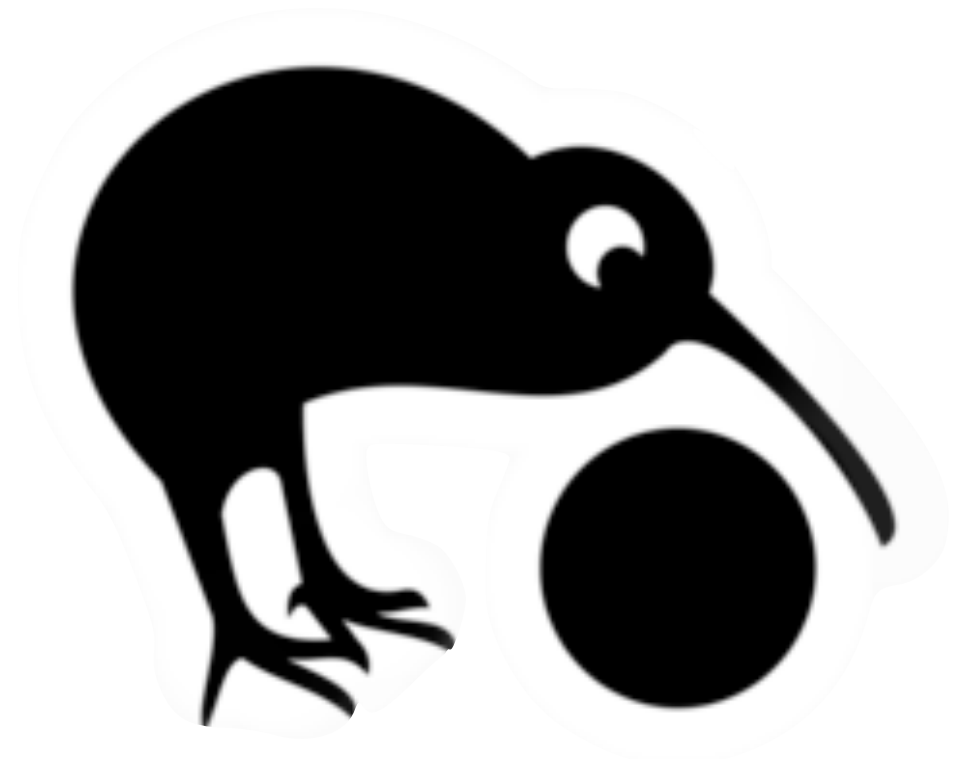

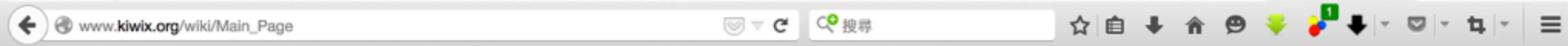

## ★ What Kiwix is...

**Kiwix** is an offline reader for web content. It's software intended to make Wikipedia available without using the internet, but it is potentially suitable for all HTML content. Kiwix supports the [ZIM format](#), a highly compressed open format with additional meta-data.

Kiwix is [free software](#), which means you can freely [copy](#), [modify](#) and [distribute](#) it.

Kiwix is mostly installed in schools, universities and libraries which can't afford a broadband Internet access. It is much faster than the Internet and also can be used by many institutions to save bandwidth and reader's time. But many people use Kiwix for their own personal purposes, for example, of people suffering from censorship or prisoners.

Kiwix is really easy to use. It provides a range of features which make usage comfortable:

- Full text search engine
- Bookmarks & Notes
- HTTP server
- PDF/HTML export
- User interface in more than 100 languages
- Tabs navigation
- Integrated content manager and downloader

Kiwix is small and efficient software, usable on lower powered or old computers. It runs on a large range of operating systems, on Android and on the three main PC operating systems: Microsoft Windows, Apple Mac OSX and GNU/Linux distributions.

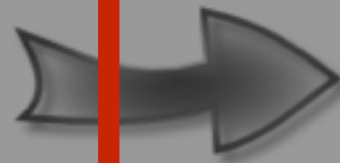
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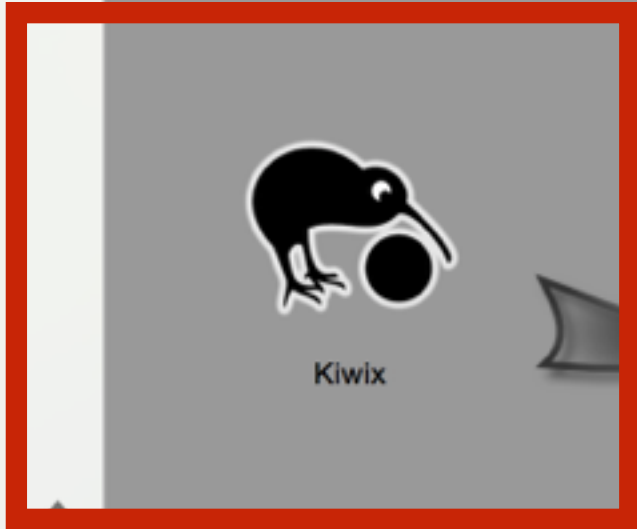

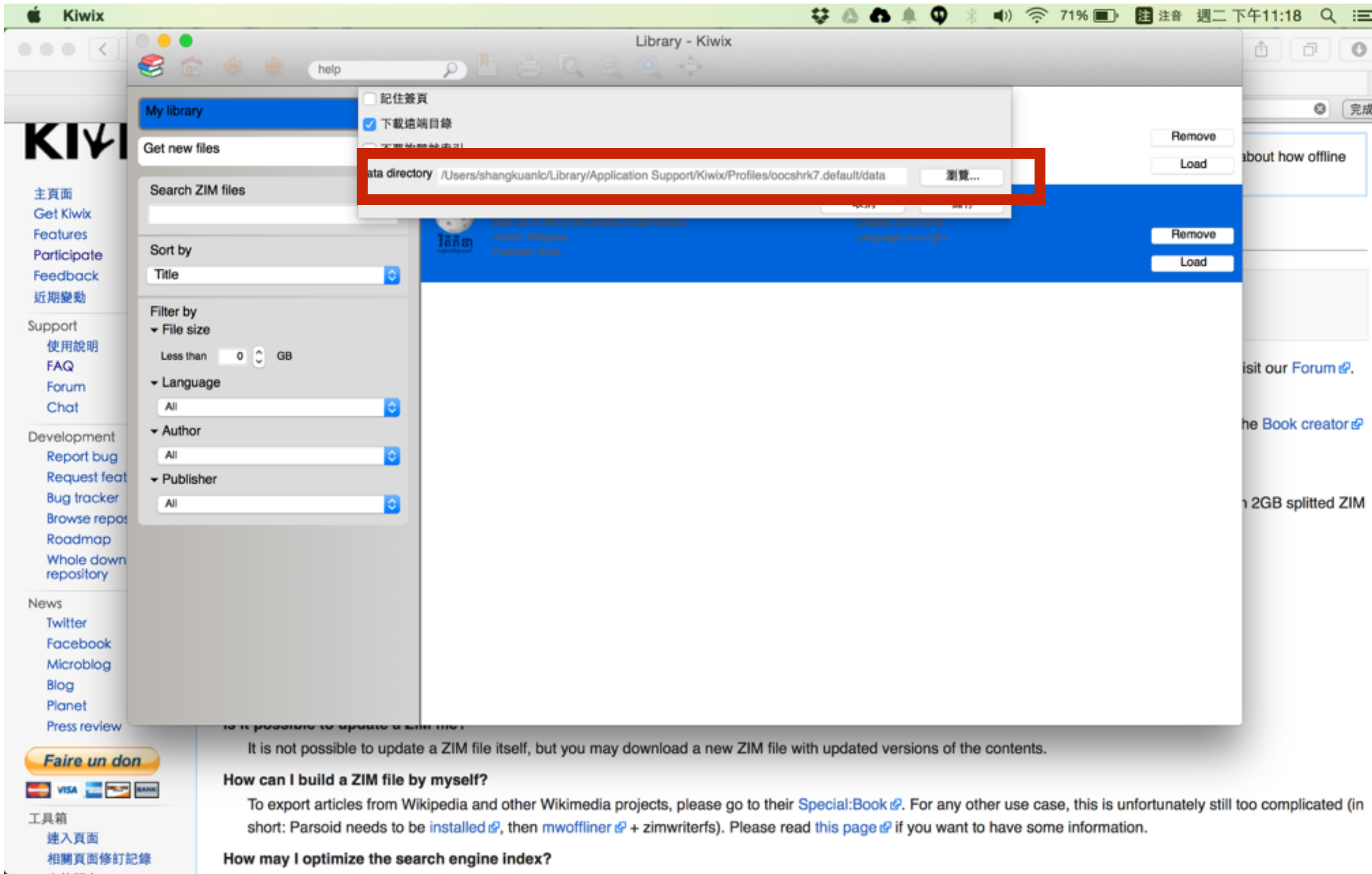
