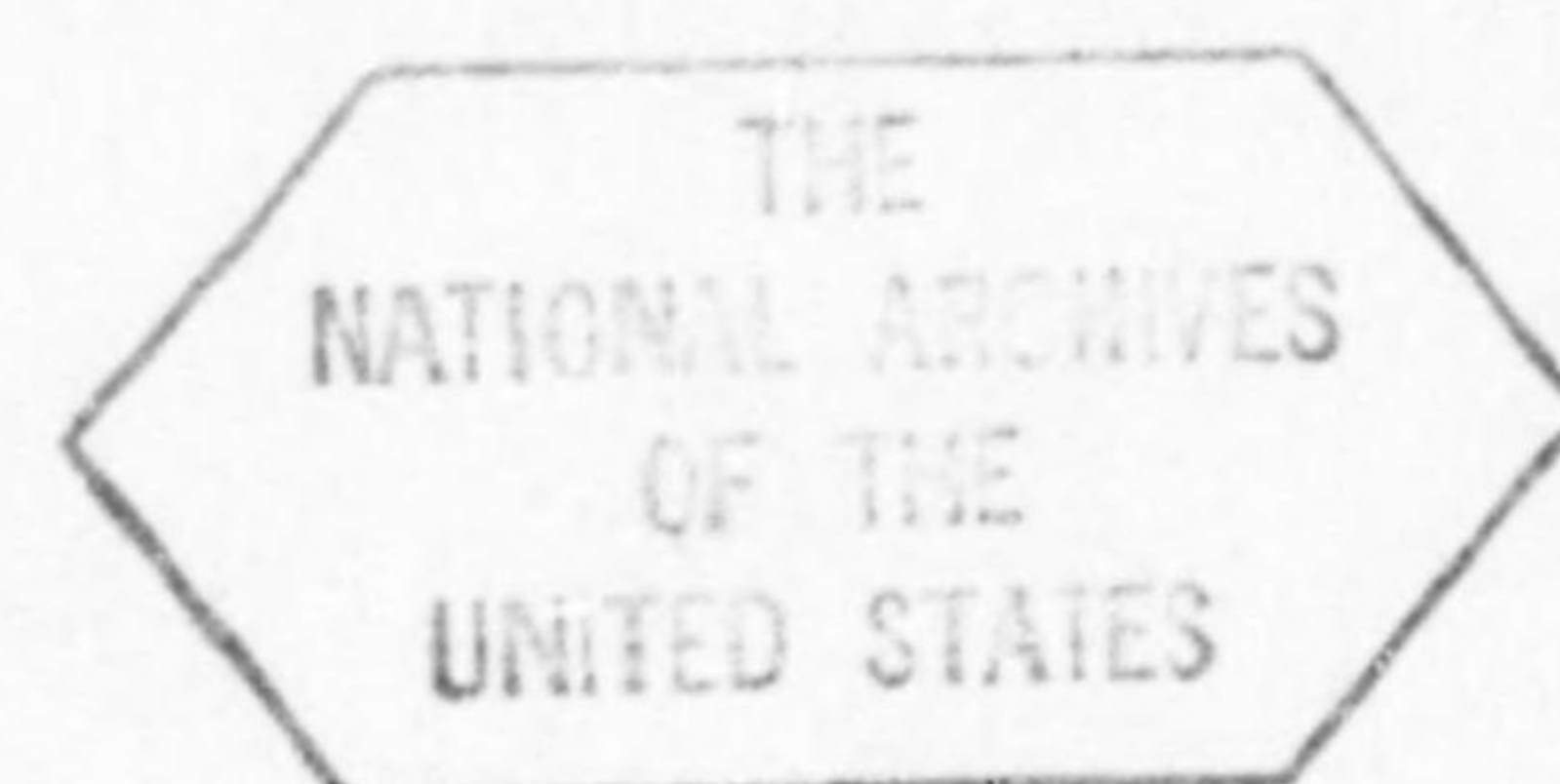

Subject bill is objectionable from the point of view of legal draftmanship in that it abolishes the Emigrants' Association Law (Law No. 25 of 1927), and at the same time attempts to add, by reference, Article 14 of said law to the Consumer's Livelihood Cooperative Association Law (Law No. 200 of 1948). This practice of abolishing a law in toto and then attempting to retain part of the said law in another law by reference, is bad legislative technique and utterly confusing. It is suggested to use the following procedure: enact two separate laws, one abolishing the Emigrants' Association Law and the other amending the Consumer's Livelihood Cooperative Association law by spelling out in said law so much of the language of Article 14 of the said Emigrants' Association Law as considered necessary.

The above objection discussed with Mr. Hoob, Cabinet LO 1/19/50. Attached bill cleared in original form notwithstanding the above.

Reasons for this action are as follows:

Law for Industrial Cooperative Assns was abolished by law no. 200 of 1948 (Consumer's Livelihood Cooperative Law) 7/30/48.

Law No. 25 of 1927 (Emigrants' Assn Law) contains in Art. 14 provision of Law No. 34 of 1900 (Law for Industrial Cooperative Assn) to be applied *mutatis mutandis*.

When Law 34 of 1900 was abolished, addition of Law 25 of 1927 was inadvertently not included under Art. 14 of Law 200, 1948 making Law No. 25 somewhat inoperative. In the attached amendments, connection of Law No. 200 is effected before abolishing Law No. 25, omitting legal provisions which were lacking from 7/30/48 to date of abolishment of this law.

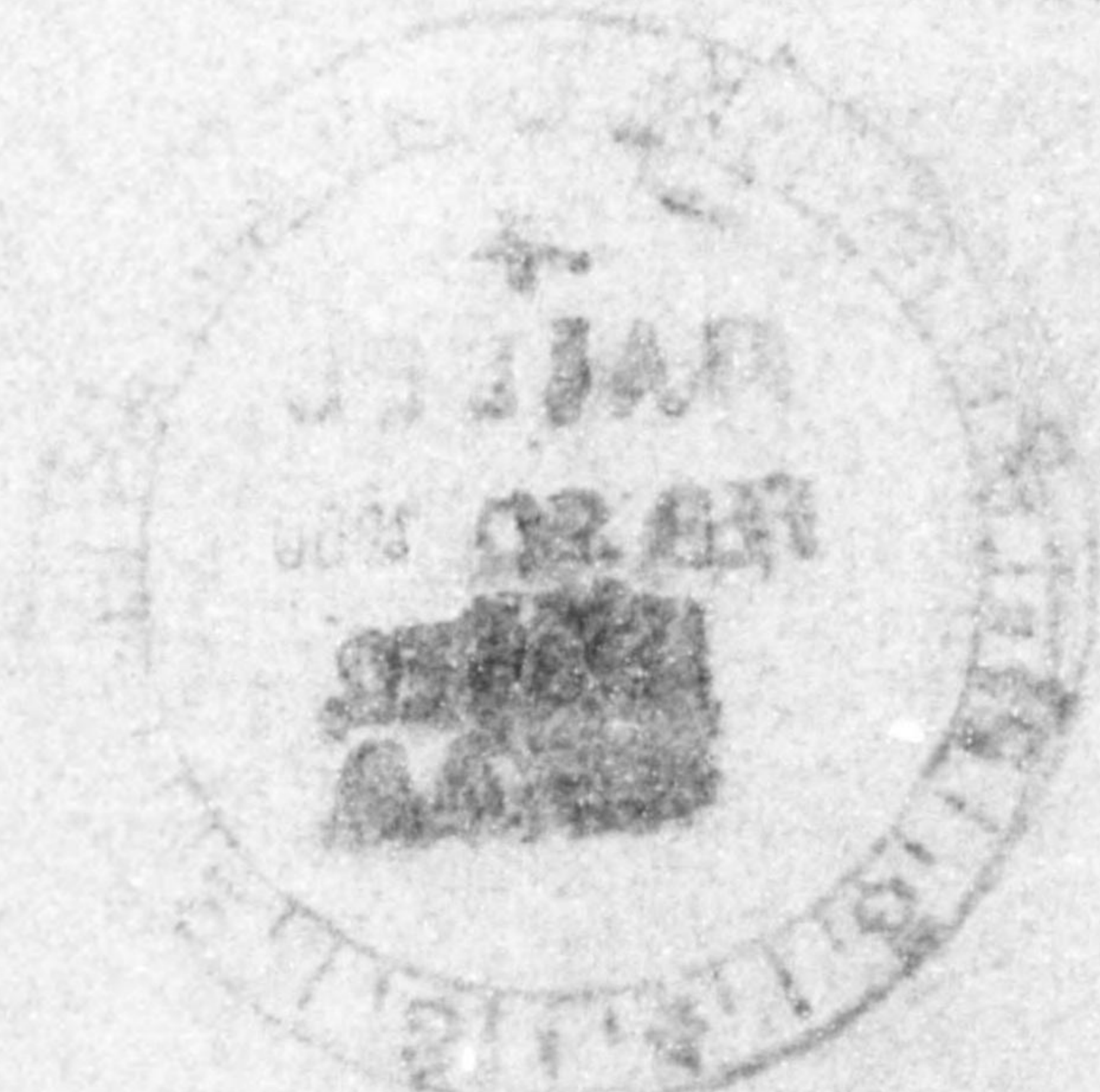


