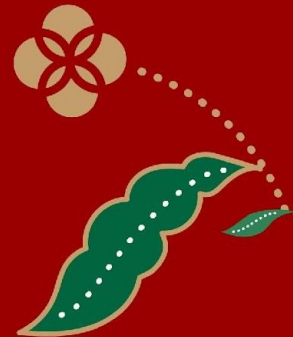

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GLAM in Germany

- Individual Editors do their usual work but also in Commons and Wikidata etc.
- They keep on track on the GLAM-portal
- GLAM on Tour Events (whole weekends)
nearly 50 since 2013
supported by WMDE (travel and accommodation)
- Wikipedianische KulTour (one day/afternoon)
since 2015, a little sister of the GLAM on Tour
less organizational effort
- GLAMdigital (streamed events)
started during the lock-down
continued, because it is a low-level way to engage with institutions

The support level

- The Chapter Wikimedia Deutschland
 - Has its own Projekt
 - “ GLAM – Kultur- und Gedächtnisinstitutionen”
 - and various other departments covering
 - Political lobbying
 - Open education and open data
 - Eventmanagement
 - Communities & Engagement

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GLAM in Germany (cont.)

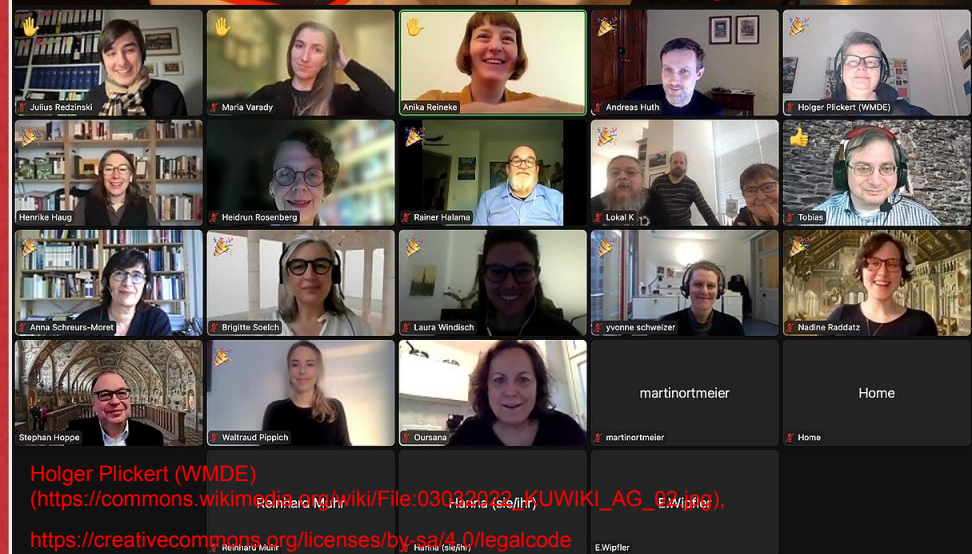
Special Initiatives

- The annual meeting of all German Speaking GLAM-volunteers usually in Fall, rotating between Germany, Austria and Switzerland
- The Community initiated, but Chapter supported “Kulturbotschafter”
(listen to my lightning talk after the lunch break)
- kuwiki. Arbeitsgemeinschaft Kulturwissenschaften + Wikipedia an initiative bringing together arthistorians (from students to professors) with wikimedians (see their poster at the Poster Session)

GLAM in Argentina

- Most of the work is carried out by the chapter.
- The digitization project, our main focus.



With either training sessions or by our Wikimedian in Residence.

An 8 years old project, with more than 2400 books, 5000 photographs, and 2000 historical documents digitized and uploaded to Commons. (Go check Mauricio's poster session!)

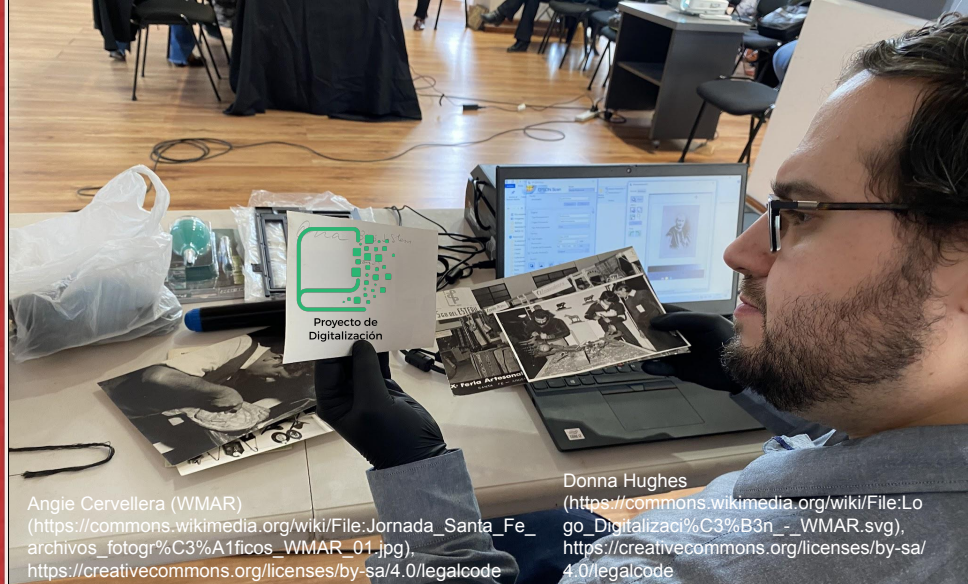
- Training sessions.

We approach institutions and we teach them about how to carry out digitization, intellectual property, and how to interact with the various Wikimedia projects.

- Courses!

Teaching the general public and professionals about free culture.

Hopefully next year I will tell you about my project!

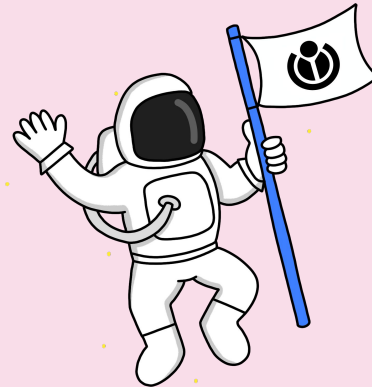
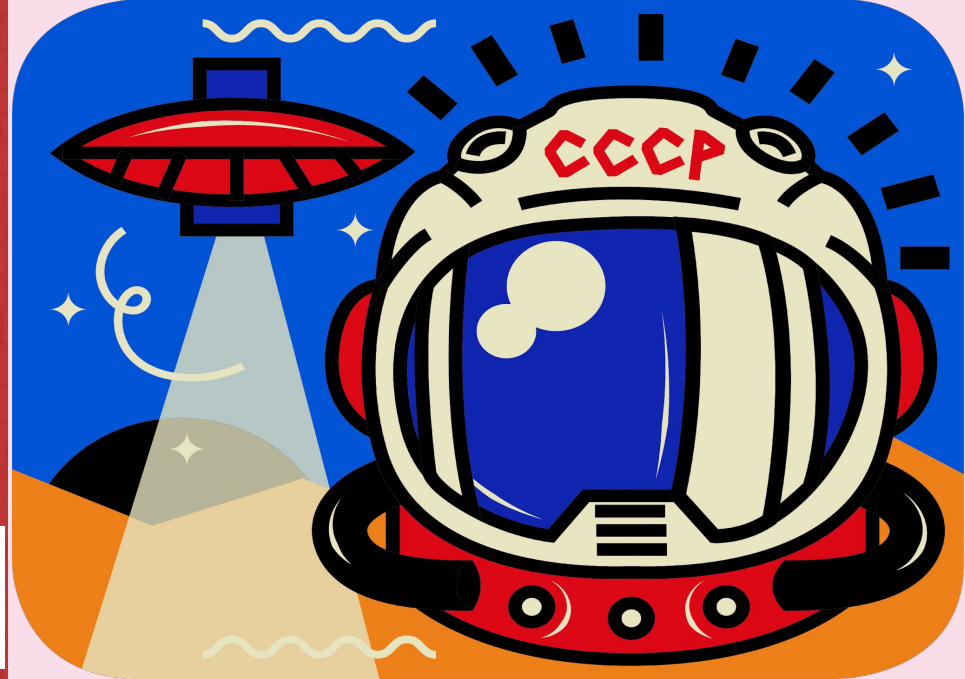
- There are some community led projects that are appearing with support from WMAR and WMF.

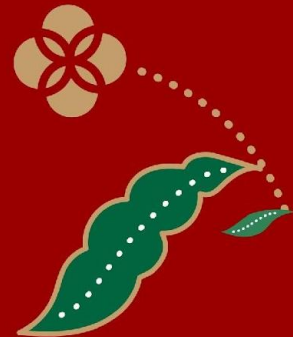

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Similarities observed

- There is great support from the Chapters
- Same difficulties to approach institutions from the volunteer level
- Highly engaged individual Editors

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Differences

Germany

Most of the work is done by the community on a volunteer basis

Argentina

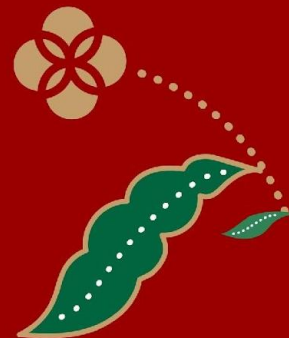
Most of the work is carried out by the local chapter, either training institutions or a staff members carries out the work

Resources

Large Community/More staff and money (own money)

Smaller Community/Less staff and money (greater dependance from WMF?)

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Differences

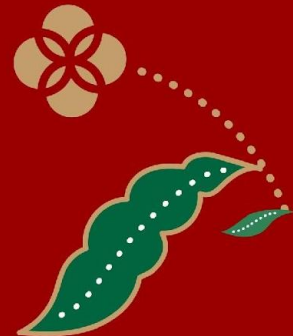
Germany

Self content Community that doesn't share much of its activity with the global GLAM-community (the language barrier is one reason)

Argentina

We share our activities at Wikimedia Outreach to keep in touch with the rest of community

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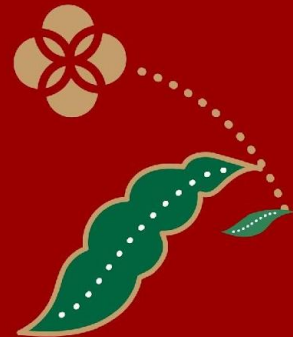
Lessons learned
