Tom Wood contacted the Henry Ford Museum which has an archive of his letters and writings. They politely declined to help this rather telling statement: "In the past research on this topic has not yielded satisfactory results either for the researcher or research staff. Mr. Ford wrote numerous articles for a variety of periodicals and newspapers and the quotes attributed to him varied and often unsubstantiated.'



...is the biggest *risk*


