SUBJECT: Personnel Reduction Demobilization Board

1. Reference is made to Memorandum from Imperial Japanese Government, C.L.O. No. 6937 (PP) Subject, "Retirement of former Generals in First Demobilization Bureau and Local Assistance Bureaux", 16 Dec 1946.

2. The plan for retirement of former generals as submitted in the above referred memorandum is approved and hereby designated as Annex No. 1 to "Outline for the establishment of the Demobilization Board" dated 22 May 1946 as submitted with C.L.O. Memorandum No. 2473 (PP), which was approved by SCAPIN 993, dated 1 June 1946.

3. Authority is further granted, subject to compliance with paragraph 8 SCAPIN 550 dated 4 Jan 1946, for the retention of former General officers in the following positions of the First Bureau of the Demobilization Board:

- (a) Director of the Bureau
- (b) Assistant Director of the Bureau
- (c) Chief of Legal Division
- (d) Chief of Intendence Division
- (e) Supervisor of each District Demobilization Office
- (f) Liaison Officers with the 8th Army and with G-2, General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers.
