

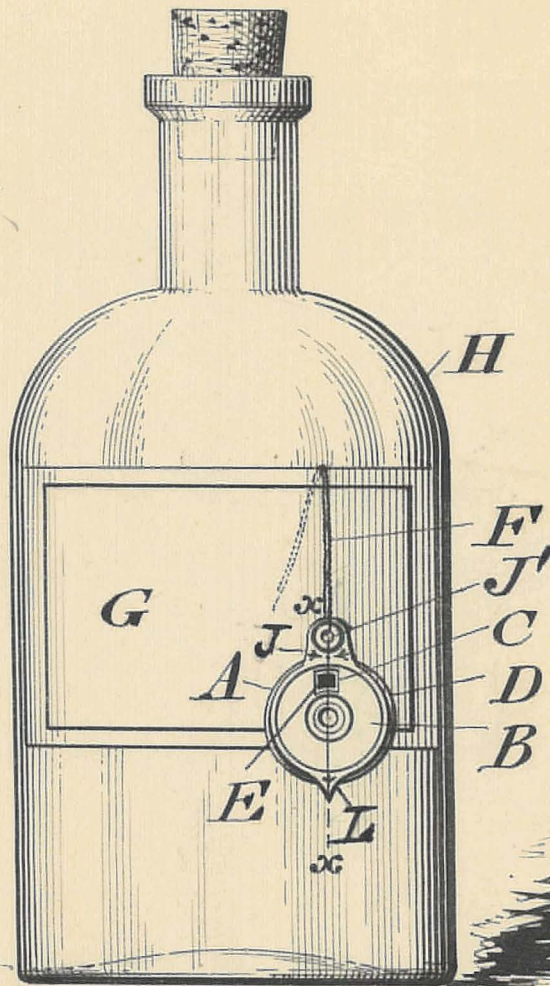

Claim.—A time indicator for the purpose named, consisting of a face plate with an opening therein, and provided with an upward extension or lip with an opening therein, and a depending tongue opposite said lip, and a dial pivoted to said face plate having a series of numbers, and a blank space thereon, said dial being wider than said face plate and said lip and tongue extending beyond the edge of the said dial, said parts being combined substantially as described.

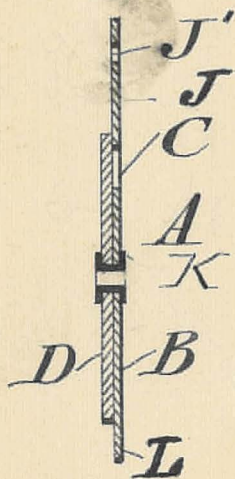
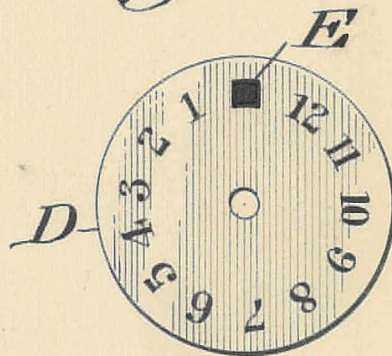
