Attached is a Spanish-language letter addressed to the Associan Ambassador to Spain, and signed by one Antilia PERIS, alleging in the first paragraph that the author has some information of interest to impart. After opening the second paragraph by saying that he had to flee Paris due to an indiscretion committed there, the author states:

"There (apparently Paris), in the home of some American friends, I got hold of an authentic document about the assassination in Dallas, which they say was swiped from the Warren Commission and which is certainly prejudicial for President Johnson. I have it on good authority that they are currently trying to sell it to no less than the Director of "Paris-Match." Someone from the Embassy of the United Kingdom in Paris is involved in the matter."

The author closes by suggesting that an advertisement bg inserted in a Hadrid newspaper if there be any interest in further details.

2. There are no Station traces on Antilia PERIS, which is almost certainly an alias. Needless to say, there is no return address on the letter or envelope, which was mailed from Barcelona on 26 September 1964. We are forwarding a copy of the letter to Faris for your information and on the off chance that you may have received similar allegations; in such case, Madrid would appreciate learning the details so that we might inform the Embassy. It might also be useful to show the letter to the CDERTY representative in Paris, but this we leave to your discretion.
