SUMMARY:

Mr. Makanuki had with him yearly production, import, and consumption figures of pulp for rayon and stable fiber. He was asked to return 26 November with recent data on a quarterly basis where figures were available.

Mr. Makanuki said he had been questioned by Major Tate, GHQ Ec. & Sci. Division about the present condition of the industry. He said that some rayon pulp plants were shut down completely because of the decrease in demand from the rayon mills. The latter decrease was caused by shortages of raOH and coal. Coal was required for making CS2.
