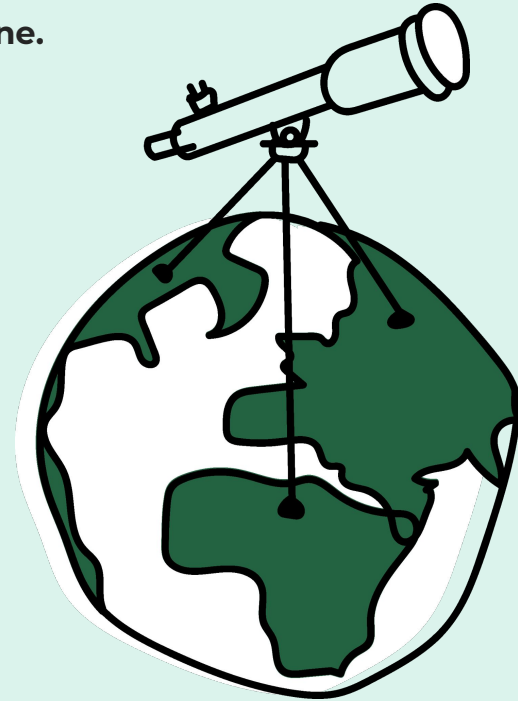

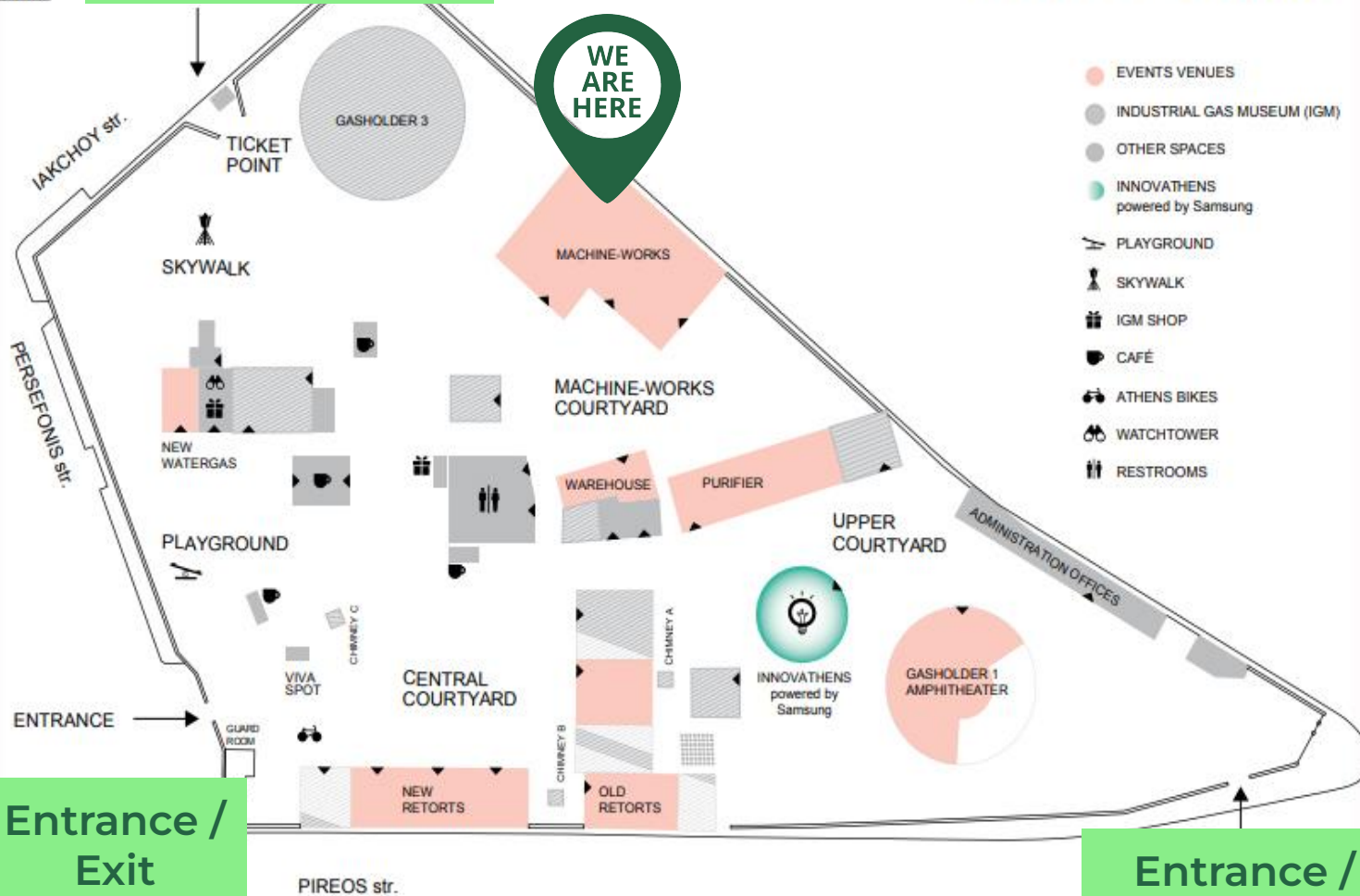
While you're here, make sure you walk around and explore this beautiful former factory turned into a cultural center.

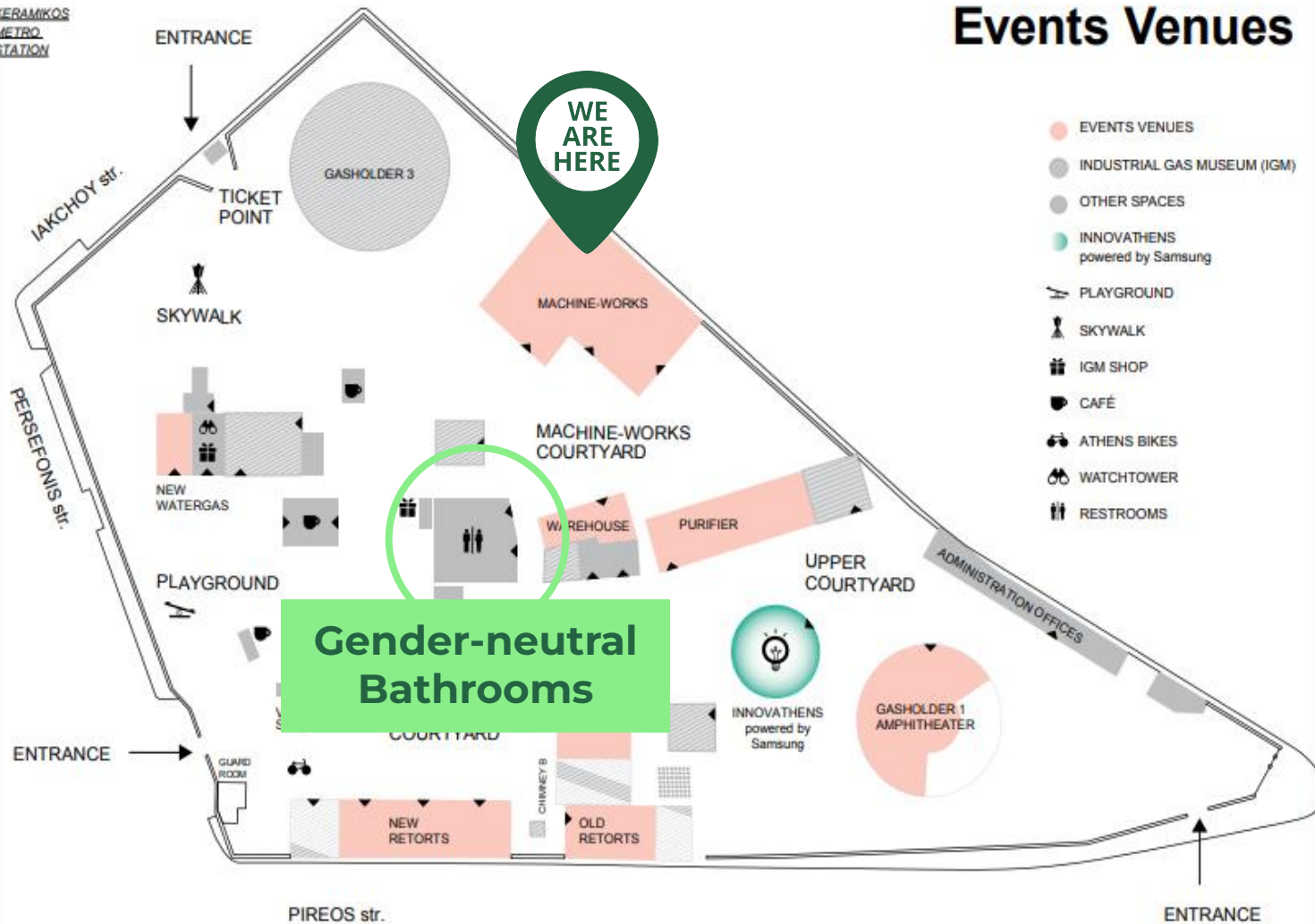

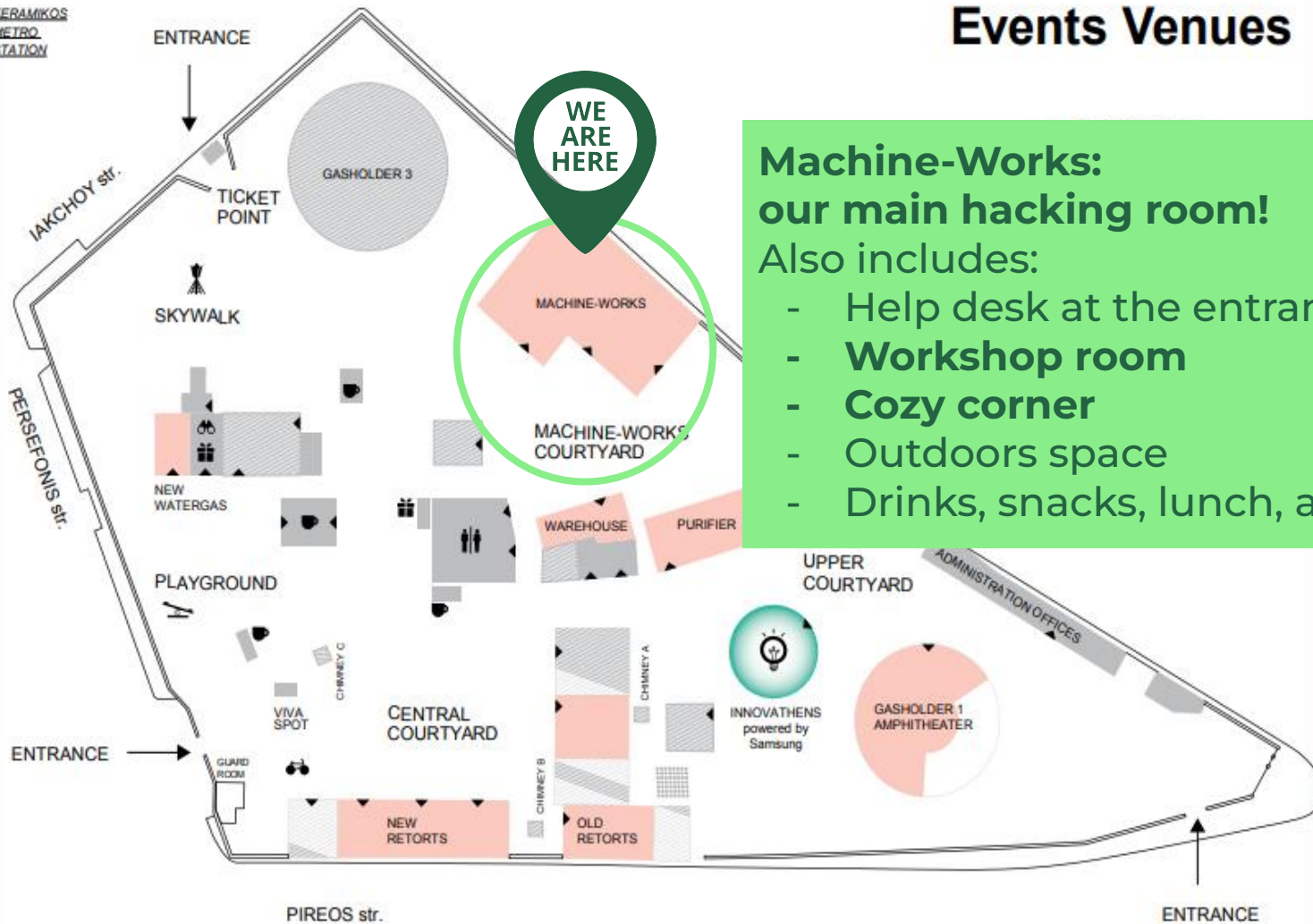

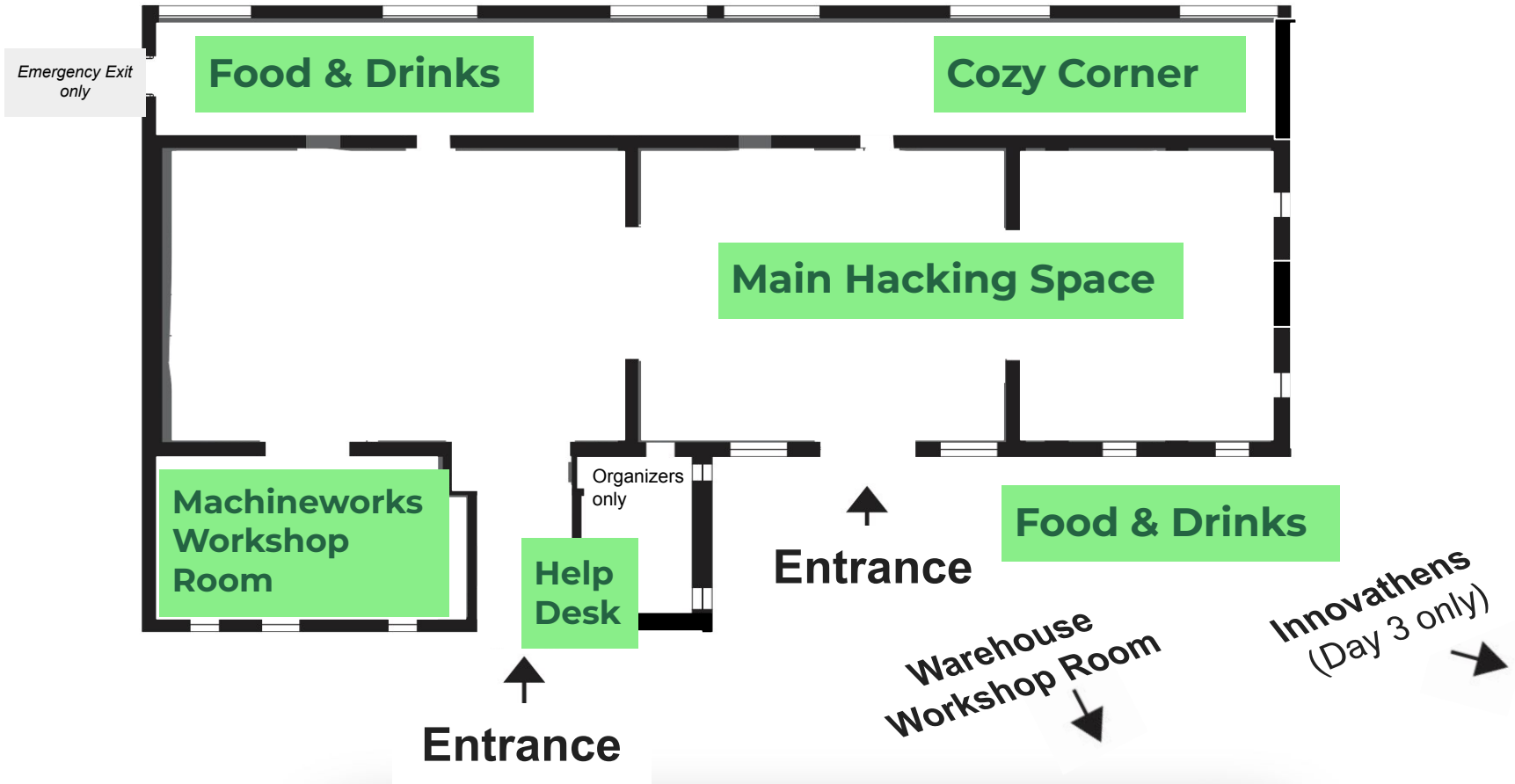


Machine-Works: our main hacking room!

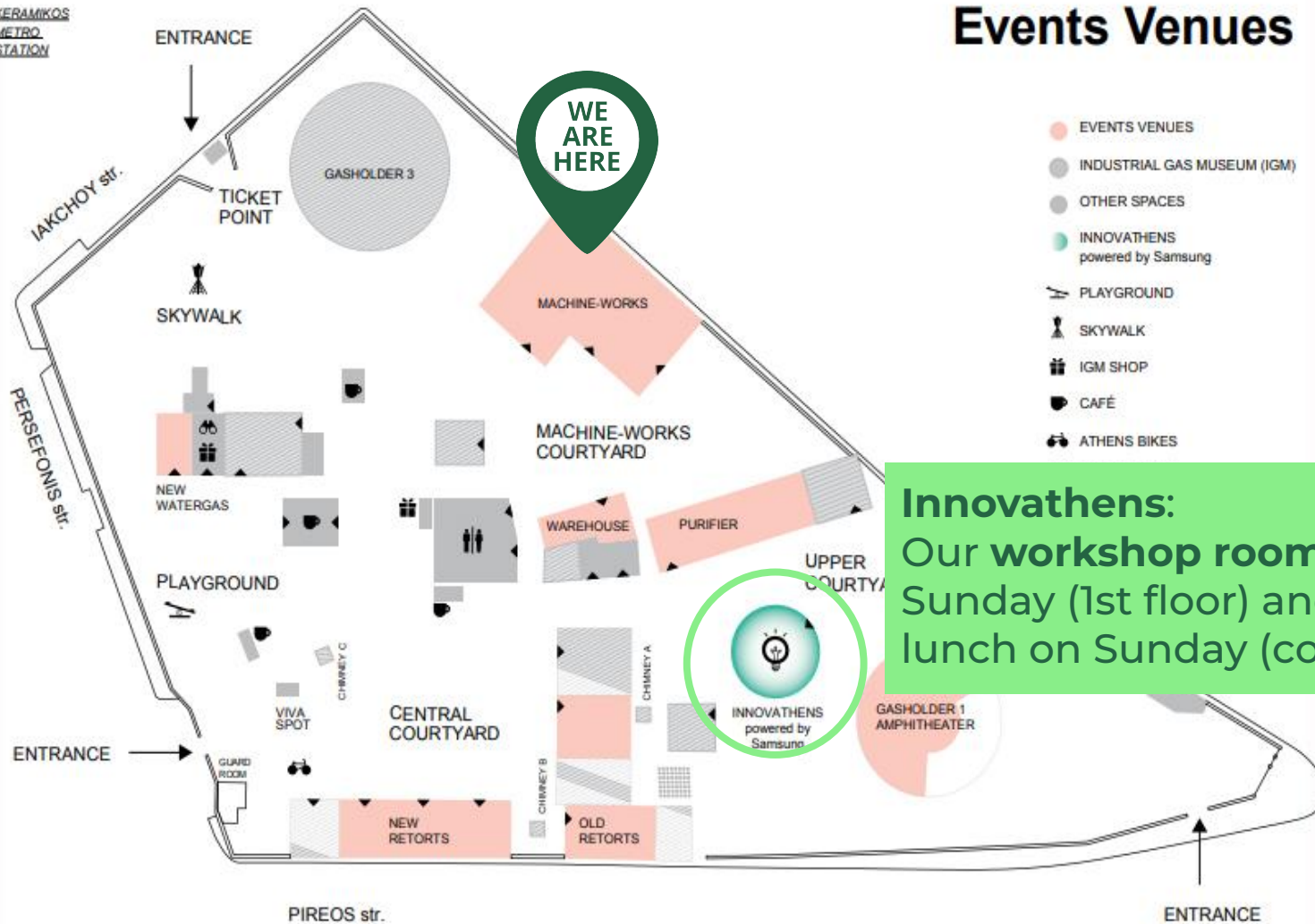

Share electricity access

Our venue is a historical and cultural place, and although we did our best to upgrade the electricity infrastructure, some issues remain.

In particular, the **two workshop rooms** will have a very limited amount of power plugs, and not everyone will be able to have their devices (laptop, phone, etc.) constantly on charge.

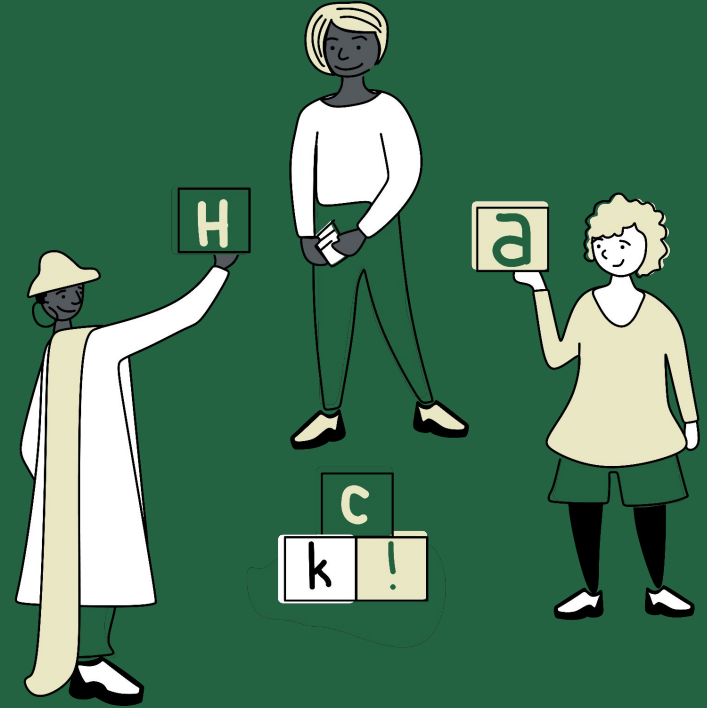

Technopolis is a **public space**, with other events taking place at the same time as the Hackathon and lots of people walking around.

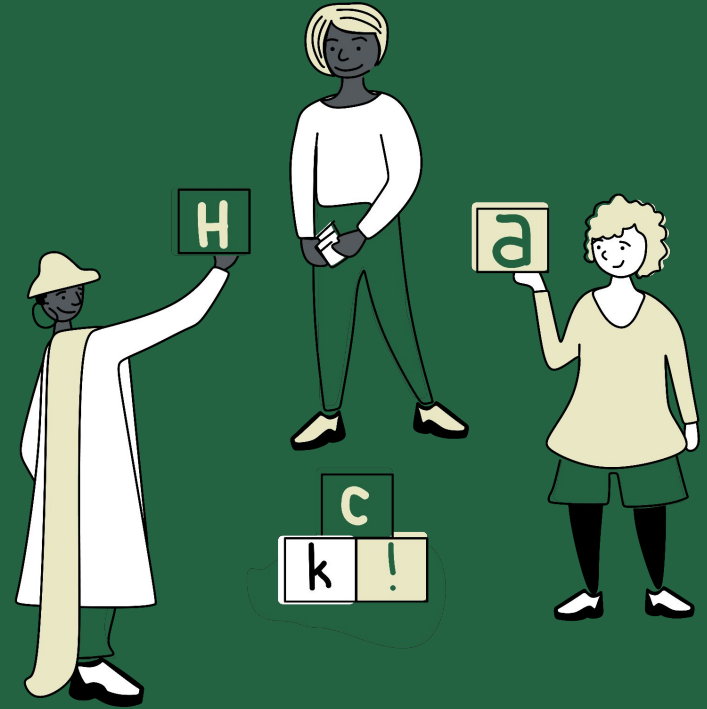
Always keep an eye on your equipment and **keep your valuable belongings with you.**



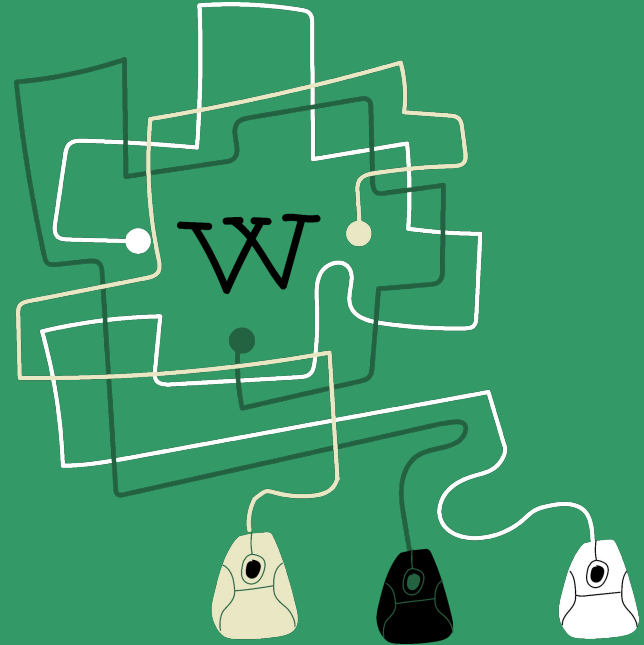
Safety tip #2: behave carefully in the city

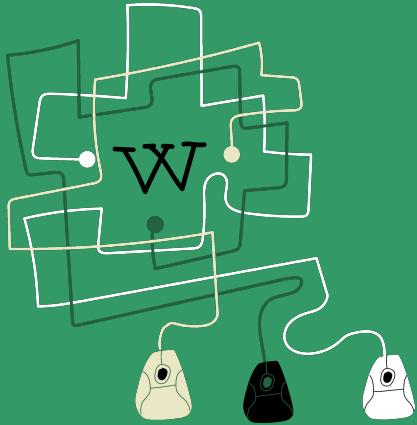
If you do not feel comfortable exploring the city on your own, you can **find other people to move with you** (ask on the Hackathon Telegram group).

Invest in planning
April 2022
Final presentation

Re-iterate over planning
1st local meeting to plan, discuss and share

Allow interaction time between participants and organisers

Attract & engage volunteers

Do a lot of online media publicity

Do also lots of local news coverage (print/local & electronic media)

Offer attractive hands-on tutorials
manage the time/energy, avoid the engagement of course

Prepare concrete goals and challenges

Offer a self-paced participation path

Put in some gamification

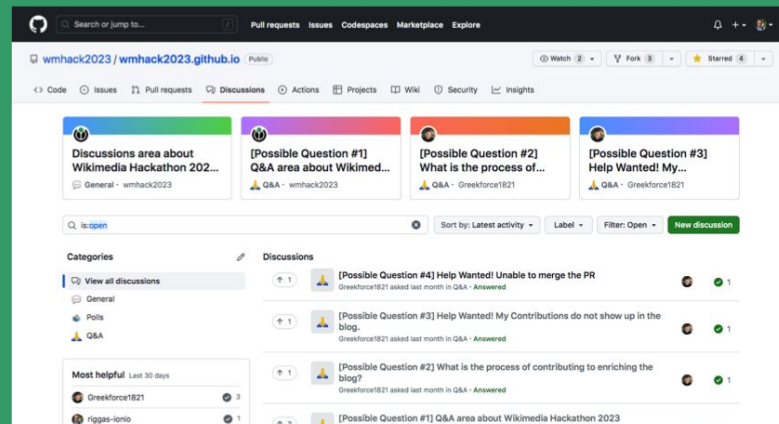

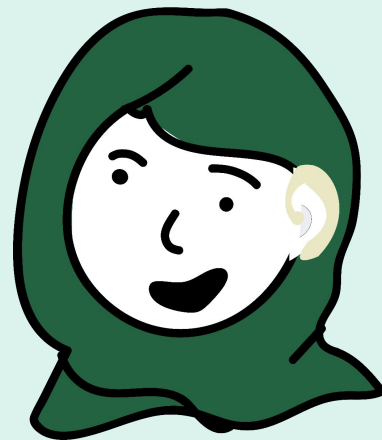
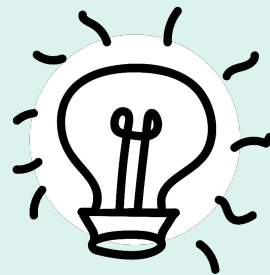
