




Early Market is a splendid large flat-seeded variety producing a heavier set of pods than Burpee's Bush in addition to being 4 to 10 days earlier. The plants are slightly shorter than Burpee Bush and of rather compact growth. Early Market is a very prolific voriety with smooth, almost straight, dark green pods bearing 3 or 4 light green beans each. The pods average over 4 inches in length and are of very attractive appearance.
