

## NOTES:

## 1. FOR OPERATION OF EQUIPMENT IN PROTRACTED COLD TEPERATURES BELOW 10° F.

Remove lubricant prescribed in the key for temperature above  $10^{\circ}$  F. Relubricate with lubricants specified in the key for temperatures below  $10^{\circ}$  F.

**2. OIL CAN POINTS.** Every 10 service hours lubricate all linkage, pins and clevises with HDO.

3. CABLES. Keep cables clean and lubricated with HDO. CAUTION: Do not lubricate cables coming in contact with excavated materials.

**4. ENGINES OIL FILTERS.** Every 100 hours remove filter element, clean housing, install new element, fill crankcase, operate engine for five minutes, check for leaks.
